Well, it's very kind of you to have me, Julie. I appreciate seeing you.

Oh my gosh, the pleasure is all mine. You say, love never dies and death is only a graduation towards more life. Tell us what you mean by that.

I believe that, no matter what happens to us living on the earth, whether we perceive it as good, bad or indifferent, that no experience is ever wasted, that we're learning to be more perfect, loving souls, and that only the body will ever die. Consciousness, we know, goes on forever. We're eternal beings of light and we take all of that love and learning with us.

Couldn't have said it better Perfect, how'd you go from bringing an administrator at Stanford University, no less, to being a medium? That's quite a path there. Was there a catalyst that caused you to go in that direction?

It definitely wasn't a conscious choice that I made. What happened was I spent so many years of my life trying to fit in, be normal and hide the abilities that I was secretly developing all along. I was born seeing colors and lights around people. I was born knowing what was going to happen next and all those sorts of things, and I got bullied at school early on, so I very quickly figured out that that wasn't cool. That wasn't going to get me the finer things in life and the interesting jobs that I really wanted.

I did not set out to do anything with mediumship or teach mediumship or any of that, but I had these great jobs and I always felt like something was missing. I couldn't pinpoint exactly what it was, but you keep getting promoted and keep getting degrees and just feel like isn't there

something else here for me? And in 2007, I had a near-death experience and it really refocused me on what's important in life and afterlife. But I also found that having that brush with physical death flipped me into some kind of high gear. I had to go back to all those teachers I was secretly going to to develop my gifts and now learn how to tone them down and live a normal life and I eventually realized this is my life.

It's so interesting how we're led, isn't it? I was in the medical industry on the supply side for 30 years, as a sales rep, first right out of school, and then started my first company at 25, and I'm an inventor of surgical devices sold throughout the world. How did manufacturing companies sold that a few years ago, and I was interested. I read a book that talked about a medical intuitive and I thought what the heck is that? And so I was led to read that book and then search more information, and that's what led me to the healing side of the equation. And what I realized is, once you connect with spirit, you can do it all, which is why I say I'm a buffet of psychicness. You know you can do everything, and I know you've discovered most likely the same thing, and so I find it fascinating. What leads us, what's the catalyst that really gets us to say, okay, all right, we're going to do this. Tell us about your near-death experience.

I was having a lot of sinus infections and I felt so sick all of the time, and so I went to an allergy specialist to figure out exactly what am I allergic to. Maybe there's something they can do for me. And I had already been into Reiki and energy healing and I thought well, this isn't working. It might help relax me or help me with the symptoms, but there's something going on here. With the allergy specialist I'd already had one level of testing, and you know how they pop these allergens onto your arm. They're breaking the skin, putting a little bit of the allergen in there, whether it's grass or mold or an animal or whatever and they see how your skin reacts.

Well, I was back from my second round of that kind of testing and my arm was really blowing up and getting really red. I got really warm and I told the technician who was doing the testing I don't feel well. And then I started to feel this dread and this panic. I told her I was warm, I was nauseated. She thought maybe she needed to adjust the air conditioning and like no, no, no, I don't feel well, I'm sick, and I started breathing really fast and she left the room.

She went to go get help and in that time my throat was closing. I was honking like a goose. When the two doctors came in, two techs came in. One technician started holding me up by my shoulder. I was sitting on the exam table and the other technician was holding up the other shoulder and one of the doctors was saying hold her up. Hold her up so they don't want me to lie down. One doctor is on the phone and another doctor is throwing open cabinet doors and I'm watching this and as I watch this doctor going for something in the cabinet, it was going to be an injection for me. He slowed down, Julie, he was in slow motion.

Everybody was in slow motion and I heard a pop like a champagne cork and it seemed like it was somewhere in down the hall in the distance, but it was me popping out of the body.

And right. I'm standing a little ways out of the body behind me, looking at the back of my head, looking at the technicians holding me up, looking at the doctor on the phone, looking at the doctor preparing an injection. They're moving so slow and they looked very unreal to me. They looked one dimensional, flat, shiny, and their eyes were like dead eyes, like no life there, like that's not real. What I'm doing is real. And then I felt the arms around me. I knew I was safe

and I knew it was my grandfather, who had passed years before, who I'd missed very much, because he really understood me.

And I heard music and saw colors and I wanted to go to the music. I wanted to go to the colors. I mean the colors. I still to this day can't describe them. Sometimes, every once in a while, I'll see something in the dream or I feel like I'm on the astral plane and I'll see some colors, but still it doesn't. It doesn't really. I can't replicate that and I can't replicate the music that I heard.

I play a few instruments and I've played piano since I was about five years old, and so I was listening to the music and the music was sort of like a, like a siren call, like a guide, like come with us, type of feel to me, to my heart, to my soul, and it kept going. It was in a major key for those of you listening to understand that, and it was in waves and going towards a crescendo that didn't quite seem to get there. It was like you want to go to that music, you want to hear it finish, you want to join with it and have it play out. And it was like voices as opposed to instruments. I can even remember thinking what instruments are these? And so I'm like oh, grandad, let's. I'm so happy to see you, let's go. And I'm not seeing him, mind you. I'm just feeling him with the arms around me. And then there's this weird voice. It's not him, I don't know who this is. It's a very flat, robotic voice saying your work has not started.

And they get that back in the exam room, they get that injection into me and I'm just kind of pulled unceremoniously roughly, to be perfectly frank back to the body and it was horrific. It's, my chest is on you. I don't know if you can hear my voice crack, but I can't. First off, I couldn't share this with very many people for years and now when I do, it's like it's happening again. In a way it's very emotional. So I have to kind of center myself.

But the hardest part was coming right back to that body and feeling like my chest is on fire, my throat's on fire. I had been honking like a goose. I felt my. When I left that body my heart rate had slowed down, it was gone, it was stopped. But you're not going to die in a doctor's office with, you know, four people there to help you. And they've got, you know, they've got a fix right there. But I'll tell you, in those that minute I sure had a heck of an experience.

And in the ambulance I now I could see my granddad and spirit. He was like floating at the top of the ambulance and I'm lying there looking up and I just it's so hard to process, but that was the beginning of objective clairvoyance re-entering my life, which is, as you know, their subjective clairvoyance, which is seeing as though in the mind's eye, and there's objective, which is seeing as though it's an object in the room, and that was on and I did not know how to shut it up In the hospital when I got to the hospital. Imagine all the souls walking through there that I could see. And I'm going wait a second. I'm not trying to see this what's happening, but I saw it's a lot of loves. I felt I wanted to be part of that love. I wanted to do work somehow in that love.

But at first I had to process and I didn't think about it for a long time, julie. But I was pretty ticked off that somebody in that in-between place thought I wasn't working hard enough or that I hadn't even started my work. I'm working a lot of hours. I'm in a PhD program on the weekends. I'm exhausted. I'm thinking if I'm not working hard enough now, I do not know what God wants from me.

And it did not go well for me at first. Afterwards, I'm not one of those stories of wow, what a wonderful, life-changing thing. I'm more of a story of wow, I don't know what to do with this. So I'm going to self-medicate for a while. And so I was like 6 PM every night and all week and drunk for a while, just trying to tune out the souls, trying to tune out what to do with this. And it took going back to the teachers and I was sitting in a development circle and it took going

back to the development circle and that teacher and saying what do I do with all this? And he's like, just ask them what they want. Just ask them what they want when they come.

But the souls were very intrusive in my life until I realized I had the authority, I had the personal sovereignty to deal with what was going on around me and I just needed to exercise it. And then it got to be exciting, it got to be fun. I could take the skills I had in designing an MBA program and apply it to teaching. But I had to get years of experience first and I became more like. I think this is what my granddad was preparing me for when I was a child, because he died when I was 14, and he came to me right after he passed suddenly at 56, dropped dead of congestive heart failure. He came to me and pretty much said everything's going to be fine and you'll see. But it was a very rocky transition, I'll tell you, because I'm walking away from the known and to the unknown. But I've not looked back and second guessed it since.

Right, oh, my goodness, that's a lot to unpack. First of all, I have an experienced, a near-death experience. But I've experienced one time my filters get blown, so turning off and on, kind of like the Chakra has filters on them and I can see that when I'm scanning somebody's Suzanne, because there's this geyser of energy flying out the top of their head. So I put the filter back on. It looks like a contact lens to me, but it has little tiny, microscopic holes in it so the energy can go in and out.

But we're not supposed to be just wide open, and so that's what I was hearing when you were talking about it. It was like, oh my God, they were ever I call it turning my radar on and off. I'm sure you have come up with some kind of a technique to do that too, because we're supposed to have the human experience. The other thing about the colors I've heard that from other people with near-death experience and also with spirit, they say that colors are so magnificent and magnificent and our colors here on earth are like not even a blip on the color scheme in heaven. Would you say that?

I think so in heaven. I think it may be even more than what I saw, because I was kind of like in the airport to the other side of left, you know, I didn't get to leave the airport.

Why in the terminal? Terminal's great Love it. But I have to say my conclusion for myself is that everything is alive. Colors are alive.

Except really it's amazing that is so perfect. We lose that filter in that airport or that in between state. It comes off and it's so sudden that we realize that all is consciousness, everything is alive, everything has the essence of the holy in it. And when I talk about the holy, I'm not talking

about the church, religious, dogmatic holy. I'm talking about lies which we should hold in a reverential light because it is the thing that can never really be taken from us, that connects us all. And so we can't describe the colors, we can't really describe the music, although one time I remember giving an interview to a wonderful person from the BBC who was trying to conduct a dead symphony, trying to interview near-death experiencers and create music, and the product was interesting.

But I knew I didn't want to discourage anyone, but I knew from the outset you can't get there because we're not going to experience it in our earthly body. While we're in our earthly body we can't experience all of it because of the filters. So we're here having other sets of experiences that assist us in our growth. Once we get to move through that doorway to other dimensions, we get closer to the truth, closer to that unity and closer to that oneness where it's like, oh my gosh, there's this whole life force, energy that exists, that I've been paying lip service to. I can cognitively talk about it and I believe it and I trust that it's real.

But once you get in it, no explanation is needed, no description is needed, and so one is not given to us, one is not offered. It's a fascinating concept and I don't think you have to have a near-death experience. I think it can be an experience of light, a moment of an epicity, an out-of-body experience, a shared death experience. There's so many ways to touch that unity, to feel that energy. But, yeah, it's fascinating to be the whole concept of filters and not having filters and the fact that clairvoyance like you and I can see when somebody's wide open or see when somebody's completely not looking or not wanting to know the truth of the energy. But the energy is always there, whether we're looking, seeing, integrating or not.

Exactly, and I wonder if that pop was when you blew your filters. That's what I was hearing in my head was well, that was the pop when you said that, because that pressure just makes that filter pop off the top. The other thing when you were talking about that, the music sounded like a siren call. What came into my head, Suzanne, was how the sailors used to talk about the siren call of the mermaids when they'd be out on the sea for long periods of time and they'd hear the siren call of the sea.

That's exactly why I use that, because I understand that. I understand that now I'm thinking back to college and taking Western Lit and then seeing in our language about the siren call. That's exactly the feeling of there's no way to ignore that energy. There's no way, because it's a frequency that is like home, because it is home.

I have full-body goosebumps when we're talking about the mermaids and the siren calls and stuff that tells me there's absolutely something to that. The other thing that's interesting to me is I always say you don't need to do LSD or ayahuasca or whatever. Just learn who-who. You'll see all this amazing stuff, no drugs needed. Would you agree with that?

I think it's different for everyone because we don't know what that experience can lead someone to. I don't need it myself, but I'm all in favor of someone getting a jump start if they're hurting, they're in pain and nothing else has worked. But I don't think that the chemical induced experiences are there just for our fun. I think there are just another spoke and a wheel of healing. But, like you said, I can get there without a substance.

In my cases I've shared earlier a substance deadened my abilities, not heightened my abilities, and I know alcohol is not exactly the same. It doesn't work on the brain, the same. I'm certainly not a neuroscientist, but I would prefer to have people try to do what's right for them and

seeking advice from all different disciplines before they jump into some experience. But having said that, there are those with post-traumatic stress syndrome who have had EMDR or have taken ketamine therapy in the right setting and being cured in one session of either one of them. So while I'm, it sounds like I'm like you, I'm not against it, but I know there are other ways that don't require any kind of substance in your body.

Absolutely what's an evidential medium.

Well, I know that you know. But we provide evidence, we identify the spirit and then give evidence that it's really them and evidence that they're still part of your life. And I often say that, you know, we're not just telling you what you want to hear, but what you need to hear to know that that love one is there. And I've submitted myself for a scientific testing at the University of Arizona with Gary Schwartz there, dr Gary Schwartz and his double blind studies, his triple blind studies, not because I want to prove anything to anybody, because frankly I don't, but just to be invited is wonderful and to be able to add to the work and add to the acceptance and, furthermore, to open people's eyes.

Because we're now, I think, past the debate of is there life after physical death? They were into the debate of yes, there is. What is it like? And so everyone's learning, who wants to, how to be their own medium or intermediary between the worlds, which is great. But not everybody's going to give evidence to complete strangers that their loved one is there. But everyone can be their own medium to their own beloved people, pets and guides who now live in the world after this.

Exactly, I'm involved in that project as well on the business side as an advisor to help raise money and, you know, be kind of an intuitive who also has a business background to help on that side. And for those of you that don't know about the Soul Phone project that Suzanne and I are are talking about, they're working on a I call it like a phone app where you're going to be able to utilize that and contact your deceased loved ones off of your cell phone is, I think, kind of an easy way to put it in there, developing that, which is amazing. And they've already proven to your point, Suzanne, that life exists, dr Schwartz says, after bodily death, and so I think that's really important too. You and I both teach people how to connect with spirit. Do you believe everybody has the ability?

Absolutely. That's. My dream is that we're going to live in a world where everyone who really wants to trust that they can and takes the steps to learn how to do it, and it's so healing. But I've been saying for years that I look forward to the day when nobody needs to go and get a reading, and in fact I've had just recently a time where, over for over a year, I wasn't doing Heavenential Mediumship, I was just teaching and just working with my business clients, because my background is a bachelor's in management and my master's in public affairs policy, public administration, and I also worked as a human resources executive for years and I have owned businesses myself, and so those are abilities that are in the psychic realm, that are in the intuitive realm, and it all just sort of mingles together. But everybody has the ability to do this. It's just that every once in a while we feel like we need to go and get some clarity from someone outside of us. Like I'll go through CVs for an executive that's looking to hire somebody in the C suite and all I have to do is just write the name down, put my pen on it and say guide, show me, help me feel you can come up with the strengths and weaknesses. I can look at capital improvement plans and all those sorts of things. So this isn't just about contacting loved ones on the other side. Everyone can do this for themselves. They can tune

into the SWAT analysis their strengths, weaknesses, threats and opportunities. They can tune into their cat who passed and I want to feel that you're with me because I know you're around, and they may share the meow, or they may feel the tail brush up against their leg or something like that. So we have this huge array of how to use our own gifts that are built right into the physical body. They're built into the metaphysical and the physical body. So, yeah, everybody can do these sorts of things, but not everybody can do evidential mediumship for a complete stranger. It's a gift that I feel like you're born with. You have to develop. It may lie latent within you for a long time.

Around 2014 was the first time I worked with Dr Gary Schwartz at University of Arizona. He saw me at a conference and took me aside and another medium aside, and started putting me into double blind and triple blind experiments to test mediumship, to add to the body of work and it's not because I want to prove anything to anyone. I really don't care what people believe. If it's not on your path, it's not on your path. If it is, here's the data. It's more that you want to give back to the work. You want the work to go on. You want to give legitimacy to that trust that there is a life beyond this, trust that there are intuitive abilities, that they can be defined, they can be quantified and qualified, they can be replicated, and I think that's the important thing.

I worked with Gary. I've gone to California with the university team and stayed in the haunted house and done experiments there and all that sort of thing, and I know that some of the work that we've done and he's worked with many mediums and I know that he's worked with you as well, is working with you have contributed to some of the projects that he works on, and I really love the fact that people are now taking an interest in communicating with the other side through various means, not just getting a reading. For years I've said I don't want anybody to have to go and get a reading and people have said, oh, it was so good, you're bad for your own business. I do not see it that way, because teachers are always going to be needed. Thank you.

Well, not only that, but one of the things that I suggest to clients and also people that call into my show or listen to my show and you were back to your point about you can tell what plan is the best one. I do this with people on where's the best city for them. Is this house better, is that house better, whatever. But I teach, Suzanne, and I think you're probably doing the same thing, maybe just using different verbiage, and I'll say just start with, is it in my best interest too? Dot dot dot, fill in the blanks, and our heads up accelerate dishes and they receive and they transmit frequencies and you're going to hear an answer as fast as you can snap your fingers, sometimes before you've even had the thought finish, whether the question or the comment, and that's spirited advising us, and I think we're all getting information from spirit 24-7,. We just disregard it, we don't trust it, because we think, oh, that's just my imagination.

Well, the more you do it with purpose, the more validation you get. The more validation you get, the more you know okay, there's really something to this. We're all doing it. We all have had the experience where we think of somebody and we get a text from them or an email or a call, or we run into them and we say I was just thinking of you this morning and here you are. That's your intuitive ability. We all do that, would you agree?

Perfectly said, oh my gosh. And one way to spot that and so few people do this, I wish more would is just keeping above the norm journal notebook and every time you get an intuitive hit or dream visit or a synchronicity, those freaky-key coincidences that point the way, just write the date down, write a sentence or two about what happened. And if you just jot it down somewhere in your phone or wherever, you can look back and you can see patterns and trends

and how the information is coming through. I mean, you and I are, if we're not that different from everybody else. We just work to hone the abilities that we all have.

Exactly, exactly. I see you can learn to throw a football, but it just means you're going to be Tom Brady. It'd be the winningest quarterback in the NFL. He's had a lot of practice with that so that it just becomes remote. What are some of the common questions that you get from your clients who want to speak with a deceased loved one? Are there some questions that it seems like everybody asks and what are some of the kinds of answers that you get? Can you tell us some of the stories that you've gotten where your client or the person with whom you're working what's happened? Does that help with their grief? Number one and number two Are there any answers from spirit, where they just go? Oh my gosh, there's no way you could have known that.

Every week, every single week, there's something like that, because I'm always asking please give me information that they don't expect, but it will be the most helpful, hopeful and healing. I got that phrase from Edgar Cayce, who said anytime you tune into the acacia which he also coined that term to talk about the ether the record of every thought, word and action that has ever been, is now and ever will be. He's like you must do it with right intention. The intention is that you're going to give helpful, helpful, healing information. I don't get my mind blown. I know a lot of people say to me wow, my mind is blown. I'm like great, I'm glad that you are, I expect this stuff, yeah me too, I'm built a little differently.

Yeah, exactly, it's fun. I feel like I'm built a little differently from some mediums that are like oh wow, oh my God, I'm so excited, I'm expecting this and I walk in this world all day long. I have to work to tune out, but some of the things that really amaze me are I was terrified, Julie. If I had known you then I probably would have called you for advice. But this really weird thing happened where I had this woman on Zoom and she really wanted to know if she was going to get pregnant in the year and be able to carry the baby to term. I just blurred it out yeah, your dad is saying he can see a little bit ahead from the spirit world and you'll be pregnant in the fall and it's a boy. It'd be nice if you name them after me the first or middle name.

I blurred the whole thing out and I couldn't believe it. Then it came out of my mouth but you get in that trust zone. But I'm like God, I'm on the line here. I just probably would have there's free will involved. There's all kinds of things that can happen. I'm not a predictor person. This looks likely to happen based on how things are right now and just spilled out of my mouth, and I've had a couple things like that. Then I'm freaking out and I'm calling a couple of colleagues going. What did I just do? The advice I got from them was just trust, just trust. Yes, it's anomalous for somebody to be promised something from a spirit person. You didn't promise it, you were in your zone and it did happen. I'll say this much. His name was very unusual, it's Lincoln, and sure enough she named that little boy.

I believe it's because we take our personalities and we take our styles and we take our MO with us, who we are with us, and also there can be a preference for doing something else. Maybe it's that I prefer to work with the little birdies and butterflies, and it reminds me of one time I had a fellow coming in for his love one and she said well, what signs are you sending? He goes well, I'm not going to do birds and butterflies. He was like it just wasn't cool enough. He was a real cool guy, so he did something with motorcycles and license plates and stuff like that and I'm like but it really is a matter of a preference, of choice, and also it's incumbent on the person here to be aware and be looking.

How many times have you had to explain to somebody oh yeah, that 11-11 that you keep seeing and you started seeing after your love one passed, and how often do you see it? Where do you see it? Do you think maybe that's from them and you're trying to get the dream visit? But you're, you know, failing to appreciate the magnitude of this other thing that they're doing? But you know, there's also the matter of those who say I don't ever get anything? Do they not love me? Do they not care? Do they not want to talk to me or I've? You know?

I had a person recently say you know, I tried several times to connect in readings and everybody else comes in and their brother, but this one soul never does. And that soul will have to answer one day when you're on the other side. Just ask them what was the reason? Was it just not their preference to do with that way? Another thing too is especially you asked about dream visits. Dream visits can go to somebody close to you and not to you, because it's easier to get through, Right, you know.

I'm like gosh that's so young, but I know everything's in the universe, it's in its perfect timing and I got a couple of different signs from my loved ones that they had and that he's okay, but he didn't do the big stunning signs for about three months and I'm like gosh, darn it. Suzanne, if you go back and look at videos you recorded like 14, 15 years ago, what are you saying on that? Wait about three months to get a reading, you know so. It's like I set that up myself, even that they had to laugh.

Yeah, yeah, I always say when we're grieving we're in a lower frequency, we're on the grieving frequency and spirit doesn't communicate on the I feel crappy channels because the vibration's too low, and so that's why spirit can show up to somebody who isn't maybe in such low frequencies as they're grieving, and it comes.

It's been my experience too and I'd love to hear your take on this that we all come in with a factory presetting frequency level of spirit and when we sleep at night we go back to that

factory presetting, when our brain is quiet and we're not over analyzing what we're going to cook for dinner and how we're going to pay the rent and all of those things, and so it gives spirit the opportunity to come in and communicate with us.

When we go back to that factory preset frequency level, I think of it like megahertz on a radio station. You know you're on the country music station, which is 102.5, and you're on the classic rock station, which is maybe 104.7. And so I have found that to be very helpful in explaining that to people, especially who are grieving. And I know you work with people who are grieving, as I do too. They just want some sign that they're loved one or they want to hear something, or hear a sign, or hear some kind of information that's going to let them know that they're around them and it can also get like I think there's a temptation to get addicted to needing readings and to connect with a loved one.
