Today, we have energy healer and medium Deborah Martin with us. I'm going to be asking Deborah about her healing techniques, her three near-death experiences and how she helps the FBI and law enforcement officers solve murder cases. I am so excited. Thank you so much for having me on your platform, oh my honor, let's get right into it.

You say, miracles exist and there's always hope. Nothing is too big or too small to heal. Please say more.

Well, I really believe that. I think that we put expectations on, like titles right of what illness is, and you hear something like ALS or Alzheimer's and automatically we go what? And so I really believe that we put those expectations on. God didn't make that term, we made that term and that anything's possible. So we just have to open our hearts and our minds and receive that. And so it can be from the smallest thing. Like somebody could come and I'd be like, oh, you have a sore throat and they're like she's picking up on a sore throat and they might have cancer at the same time. But we go into seeing through the body what they're all dealing with. So it could be the smallest thing to the biggest thing, but everything's possible.

Yeah, and everything can be healed is what I always say.

It is Everything can be healed. There's really nothing that can't be. But, with that said, I'm not like God who makes that decision, because maybe there's something that they need to go through as a life lesson, or that that's just their sole contract, you don't know. So I can't guarantee every person's going to be healed, but I know that every person's touched and I know that, as they are touched, they're receiving something that they need, and maybe it's something that they didn't even think that they needed. That was more than what they were asking for.

Well, sometimes the healing is the emotional side of the equation too. To your point about, I always see that we can heal body parts, but there's always an emotional component. That's part of the healing equation and I agree with you all the time it's. Their spirit is wanting to explore and experience whatever it is they're going through, whether that involves physical healing or emotional healing or whatever, Certainly it's spirit working through us and with us to help that person heal themselves. Would you agree with that?

100%. I think it's emotional, physical or spiritual. And a lot of the emotional trauma does go to the root issue of why they have the physical right. And so when we're talking emotional pain, emotional pain can be one of the hardest pains to heal because you know it's almost like it's ingrated into you. That's who you became because of that emotional trauma right. So I always say we don't want to forget it because we learned through it. It was an opportunity for growth, but we want to heal it so that you can move forward from it.

And so when I do a healing on somebody that has mental illness and I see like instantly I have one on YouTube that she talks about she had 20 years of pain, she tried committing suicide three times, she lost all hope and after one healing session everything just lifted. And she's like, oh my gosh, I can see the light. And it was like to me I'm just the instrument. So when I hear the feedback like that, I'm like, oh God, thank you, god, right, and that's the beauty of it. It's just stepping aside my humanness and allowing the being, the instrument, and allowing that frequency and healing energy to go through me. And what's beautiful is I'm shown things. I don't know anything. Most times I don't know anything what the person is dealing with, but I'm told, and so that makes it really profound. Because then when they listen to their recording, because they're in their own sacred space as it's taking place, when they listen to it they're like how did she know? Right, but spirit, god, source, whatever you want to title it knows everything about us.

Yeah, interesting. Well, it's interesting too how people I would imagine come to you they do to me, especially on the healing side of the equation when they've seen multiple doctors, gotten multiple diagnoses and perhaps multiple treatment plans and they still have the same symptoms. And so that leads them to look outside of the traditional medical box which there's always application for. If I'm in a car accident and I'm bleeding out, you better take me to the closest trauma center. Don't chant over me. I mean, like stitch up my artery that's been cut 100%.

I think we have to use every tool in our toolbox.

That's right it's part of the healing equation and and it's interesting too how I believe and I'd love to hear your take on this that nobody heals anybody else, not even the doctors. You know you have surgery and at the end of the procedure they're stitching up the incision with sutures and staples. Well, they don't make that surgeon, doesn't make your skin grow back. You make your own skin grow back. Then that's the same thing with this.

That's beautifully said. I like that. It's the same with healing your bone. Like you have a broken bone and you're taking the time to heal it, You're taking the time to nurture it. And it's really hard when people have cancer because you're healing your cancer but you don't get to see it heal. Like a bone would start to heal right. And so that comes into another play of trusting, just trusting what you're feeling and guiding. And sometimes you know the cancer doesn't heal. You know, I've seen that too and they receive on a whole different level, where then they're able to embrace where they're at and they know that all is well and will be well, no matter what. And so I think that frees you. It frees you from the pain, it frees you from the worry, it frees you from the stress. So that's a whole other level.

I agree and I say everything can be healed and sometimes the healing is death.

Yeah, yeah, I've had that. In fact, in my book I write about Brenda, and Brenda had come from cancer and we really thought she was healed, like she felt amazing. Even all her friends were saying, oh my gosh, you just look like yourself again. And we went to a root issue for her healing and it was trauma. She had trauma from her parents and I can remember God saying you know, we're going to release this trauma. And she wrote me an email that said you know, that was more important than cancer because I've held that all my life. So when she did pass, she said that I'm passing, but I'm not holding any of this. I've released this and so it's just so much more freeing and so, as the healer, you're going wow, that's pretty profound. Right that she came for the cancer, but she got something more.

Cancer was the vehicle for her to reach what she wanted. When I was growing up, and even as an adult, my mom God bless her she would go light candles in church and we called them killer candles when somebody had suffered for years or you know for worse, just in excruciating pain and the docs couldn't manage their pain and it was like enough already. You know, this person was so ready to go and so my mother would go to church and she would say a prayer and she would light these candles. And I'm telling you, Debra, these people would die within usually 24 or 48 hours, and so we used to tease her about it. We'd say, mom, are you going to go light one of those killer candles?

But I think it was a situation where there were so many people praying for that person who was in such agony and the person was ready to go. They were telling everybody they were ready to go and the family was suffering and everybody else. And I find and I do this with my call-in show I always tell people envision what I'm describing as part of this healing, because it's similar to the power of prayer. When we're all focused on the same person or the same situation, we're sending energy to them. Do you have something you can add for?

that A hundred percent. So I do a free, monthly global community called Army for Love, and so we're joining and putting love into action, and so we have no judgments. But at the top of the hour we do a mini healing, and so our intention, you know, we're holding hands. I do this in my global group sessions too. We're holding that intention of a miracle right. So, I believe, when one receives, we all receive, but that energy heightens. Now we have that same intention, and that intention, you know, becomes really profound and I think people own it more that way too, because it's like, well, I'm not deserving, that person's deserving, but if they're collectively together, they let go go. Okay, well, let's see what happens.

Well, and I think too to your point about people who aren't don't feel deserving oftentimes. And I think too to your point about people who don't feel deserving oftentimes. And I've had many, many emails over the years of people saying I was listening to one of the episodes of your show and you were doing a healing on somebody with whatever the symptom was, and this was three years after the episode had aired. And they said and I got a healing for the same symptoms that your caller had, and it was three years after you'd done that healing. And so I

say, well, time doesn't exist in the spirit world, and I would imagine that you've run into that many times as well. Can you give us an example of that?

Yes, I can, because I believe that the healing energy never loses its power or essence, and so, even when I send a recording to somebody for their healing, they'll go back and listen two, three, four times and hear things they didn't hear the first or second time, so that layers of healing keeps happening. But I also believe that if somebody else listens to it, that those words are there for them too and that energy is going to integrate in them. Many times, I'm sure when somebody reads your book, like they read mine, they go oh my gosh. I resonated that and I felt like I was being healed through those words. Words are powerful and that energy is powerful and I believe that it never loses its essence.

In fact, I'm starting to put my Army for Love mini healings for people to be able to access, because I'm seeing miracles happen right in front of us. We might have 100 people on the screen and we're all witnessing it happen. Well, what happens then later on when they turn off the Zoom and they go doing their stuff? They're like wait a minute, Deborah said. When one is healed, we're all healed, and this gentleman had been healed of a neck injury instantly and all of a sudden that night, she's like wait a minute, I have more range in my neck. Oh, I was healed too. So, yeah, I believe that the energy it might not integrate right at that moment, but it's there to integrate when it's ready for that person who's listening.

Yeah, and with whatever their journey is and what their spirit wants to explore and experience in this lifetime. Yeah, yeah, tell us about what you do. Let's say I'm a client, I sign up for a session with you on your website. Tell us what's going to happen next.

Okay, so I have three choices that you can sign up for. One's a group session, which is people gather around the world and we do a group healing session. Now you'll send your picture in. You might want to tell me what's wrong with you, and this goes with a private healing too. So you send in your picture. You might want to tell me what you're dealing you, and this goes with a private healing too. So you send in your picture. You might want to tell me what you're dealing with. You might not want to say anything at all, and so what I do?

Then, when the healing, the day of the healing, I will go into prayer and I'll either read what that person's dealing with and place it into God's hands, not eliminating it just to that, because it might be so much more, but placing those intentions out, saying thank you, thank you for healing these Not asking, but giving gratitude for it, for what's coming. And then they're in their sacred space. Right, they might be sleeping, because it's a different time zone. They might be working, they might decide to take a walk, they might be able to rest and say well, I want to try to receive and feel what she's feeling at the same time. Now, this isn't live. It has to be totally sacred time for me. So then I go on a healing table and if it's a private session, I place that picture on my abdomen, so I become their proxy. If it's a private session, I place the pictures are all around me. And so then what I do is I tap into a frequency and healing energy that I call God and I see that as a beam of light. Right, and I believe that God is love, so love heals. And so I always go to the solar plexus and I say, okay, this is where the light's going to go in. Things will come out through that beam of light and go up to the universe, but it will also come through different parts of the body.

So now that I'm tapped in, I might start seeing spiritual surgeons show up. Now people go well, I don't want just a spiritual surgeon to show up, I want just God. Well, I don't want just a spiritual surgeon to show up, I want just God to do that. Well, if I had to use the spiritual

surgeons works through those spiritual surgeons so that I can see exactly what's being done and I will feel it. There's no denying it. I will feel. I can see them cutting, I can feel the pain. I can go oh, somebody has something in their knee. Oh, somebody's dealing with heart trauma.

There's so much going on at one time that it's like I couldn't talk. It comes through me. There's never a breath or a break, like how you pause to think, no, it just keeps going, going, going, going. So then, when the session's complete, then I send that recording to you wherever you live, and then you can sit when you're ready to receive and listen to it. So that becomes yours, your healing, and you can listen to as many times as you wish.

Now there's an add-on that they can do because I use my mediumship abilities. An add-on would be in a private session. They'd say, well, I want a reading too, I want to connect with a loved one. So that morning I will start connecting. I ask the relationship of who they want to, because I want to have a direct connect. I don't want to be like, well, I'm going to bring all these other people, they go. Well, I really didn't want to talk to that person, so let's just get right to it. So then I'm like, okay. So then I get all the information, then I go into the healing room, I do my prayers and then the beginning of the session, I'm going to give them all the messages. But now I'm going to also welcome that loved one into the healing session.

And what's so beautiful about this is I might see them, and when they're in their sacred space or when they listen to it, they see them too. Some people have said they saw the nurse with the garment on. Some people say they felt their loved one hold their hand and messages will still come through. But when I'm dealing with a loved one, we get to go to a sacred space that the loved one chooses and prepares for them. So, whether it's another dimension or they see the landscape, they describe the landscape, they have an embrace, they might smell them, they get to speak with them, they hear more messages from them and it becomes really healing and it sounds like it's so far beyond and it kind of is.

But yeah, it's so like every at the end of every session I'm like, wow, it's like watching a movie. You're like, wow, can you imagine what just took place? That was awesome. And then Madison, who works for me. She's like, well, tell me about it. I'm like it's like whop, it's almost all gone, right, because it came through me and so I can just remember little bullet points. But they truly are miraculous and each and every one of them touches my heart. So, yeah, they're profound, they're beautiful, they're heartfelt, and I just come from my heart with each and every person, because you know what I just you can feel them, you can get to connect with them on a social level.

Yeah, yeah, yeah, okay. So here's my stuff. First of all, there's always surgeon spirits in the room when somebody's in the OR, guardian angels over the head of anesthesia. I'm an inventor of surgical devices, so I spent a lot of time in the operating room in my 30-year career. So not only did I scan them when I was in the OR, you know, developing a new product or testing a prototype, but I see it remotely now. That's number one. There's always surgeon spirits over the head of the actual surgeons that are performing that procedure.

I just love that you say that, because this is so important, because people have so much fear going into surgery, right, and I always say, okay, well, pray, and the spiritual surgeons will work

through your physical surgeons, surgeons, they're all there. You'll be surrounded in white light and with you saying that you work there and that's what I say. I think this would be great for viewers to hear just going, just take a deep breath and know that's your God time, that's your time just to let go and let them all work on you.

Right and trust that the surgeons that are the physical surgeons you know they're going to do their thing. When I've had to have surgery a couple of times in my life, I said to the surgeon before they wheeled me into the OR I said, hey, I have every confidence in you, do your thing. And it went great and I healed really fast and it was effortless.

I did the same thing. I try to give gratitude to them and the whole thing switches. But I also believe that I've seen the spiritual surgeons and spoke with them and they said they used to be physical surgeons but now they can do even more on the other side, so they just continue.

Same thing, I got the same thing. So then there are all kinds of other spirits that are in the room and they form like an amphitheater at the foot of the operating room table. So it's deceased loved ones and all these other spirits that are in the room, and so I'll describe them to my client. Who's the patient? Oh yeah, that's grandma Betty, and that's so-and-so and that's soand-so, and there's always a correlation between how much prayer is being said for the person and how many spirits are in the room. So I always tell my clients if they're having surgery or you know a friend or family member, I always say get on every prayer chain list. It doesn't matter what the denomination is, it doesn't matter, you just get on every list that you can when somebody who's dear to me is having surgery.

I was on the board at this motherhouse of nuns that educated my son and they're in, I think, 68 schools they run. They're on all the continents I mean, they're all over the world and I'll call up there and I'll talk to sister mary, whoever, and I'll say hi, sister, can I please put an intention on the big board and they know, I know what I'm talking about because I've done it and the big board is prayers go out to all of their schools, all of where those sisters are. So you not only have all those sisters praying, you've got all those kids in all those schools around the world praying too. Like, bring them on, right, bring them on, you know. I mean, get the Swahilis praying for you, get the Jews praying for you, get the Lutherans praying for you, it doesn't matter.

I really believe, like at the end of all my sessions, like when I'm doing live on Army for Love, I always say put your hands out now and let's give back to the world, right, because if we're all that same intention, it will be felt by somebody. Yeah, right, and that's what you're doing is. Let's just spread it, exactly it Exactly.

The other thing is when I have a healing done on me by my mentor, who's now in her 80s when I used to be with her in person and now we just do it via Zoom since COVID and I see the same thing. I'm laying down on a massage table and all my deceased loved ones' spirits are there, with a couple of other spirit guides usually, and oftentimes religious figures are in the room as well, and even my late dog is in the room and she's on her high legs and she's got her little paws up on the table. So it's all spirit, god working through all these different entities which are all a fractal of the divine. So, as I see it, it's spirit working through all of them and they show up in different ways for us so that it can help us understand it from a human perspective. Do you 100%?

Okay, and I also do healings on animals, and so our language becomes universal. Yeah, so I start to hear them and they're like I can remember, um, if you know Suzanne Wilson, yeah, I've had her on the show and she and Baron and Baron had a healing session and Baron told me he wanted lavender. And I go, I don't use oils. It's like I want lavender, it's gonna make me calm. I'm okay, let me search for some lavender oil. So I did, and so I mentioned that in the recording, like, okay, this is what we had to do. I had to start off. Well, she almost fell off her chair because she says that's what she puts on his head every night before he goes to sleep.

So I had to test it. I tested on my dog like do all dogs like lavender, like could this be like something that everybody was like? Oh well, everybody like said oh no, I got that out from my dog. My dog's like, get it away, get it away, I don't want anything to do with it. So it's, it's amazing how, like you say, they work through, they have a voice and they it becomes universal, Like when we were on the other side, when I had my NDEs, I wasn't talking like I'm talking to you, I'm talking to my mind, right, and that's the same. And I really think, with our animals, whether it's a horse, a cat, whatever it is, we are talking to them, we know what they need, they get that signal to us. So we're already talking that way.

Yeah, I want to talk about your three NDEs, but first I have pages of questions for you, girlfriend. So first I want to hear about did you come in seeing dead people as a child? Did you learn how to do this stuff? What was your path, and did you come from a spiritual family?

I did not come from a spiritual family. In fact I kind of went to all different churches and my mother was Protestant, my dad was Catholic, but all my friends were different religions. So I would kind of go with them on Sundays and that was kind of neat because I was seeing how each one was connecting right. At the age of four I started seeing spirit and I always think that when they're around that age children four and under, before they go to school because once they go to school that brain changes right. And so I started seeing them at night. They would come to me at night and I used to be really, really scared and say I don't want to hear you know, I don't want, I don't want to deal with you, I don't know you, and I would take my head this way and I would just scratch his name Steve, I'll start with an S and just take my mind off of it. And I didn't know that you could say you need to leave me right now, so years later.

it wasn't until I was on another interview that somebody asked me the same question and you know it, it really made me look back and go. Well, they were there to protect me. They were there to not to hurt me, not to scare me, but to give me this awareness. But I did turn it off. I turned it off because of fear and I tried to talk like can I come downstairs, mom, I'm scared. Nope, just go to bed. It wasn't something that it was talked about back bed. It wasn't something that was talked about back then. We didn't talk about mediums and spirits, so you didn't want to be the odd one out talking about that. It looked weird, so I closed off for many years.

Yeah Well, I wrote a children's book series of four books because I had so many moms and grandmothers say to me can you explain, can you help me explain, how my child knows information? There's no way they would know because they can't read yet. And how does my child know information about past lives? And we corroborate the information with online historical. You know documents and things. And what do we say to a small child when

somebody dies and we say, well, grandma's in heaven, and they say, no, no, she's not, she's laying in that box up there in the front of the room. And so, yeah, it's been my experience that children everybody comes in with the ability and children are told by parents or grandparents or teachers or even friends. Children are told by parents or grandparents or teachers or even friends. That's not real, it's just your imagination, and they learn to shut it off. So many of them, although I'm seeing that change, are you as well that more and more people are saying, okay, there's something going on with my kid. Is this real?

I do see that. But I also try to tell them don't try to, you know, like, be gentle with it. Let them tell you, so many parents want to be like. Let me ask, like, can you ask grandma this question? You know, don't push them. Good point, good point, yeah, just push them. Let them be open, free, feel safe to say what they need to say, and then, if they don't want to say anything at all, that's okay too.

Yeah, yeah, good point. Give them one of my books, one of my children's books. Yeah yeah, that's what they were designed to do. So let's talk about your NDEs, not one, not two, but three. What, what, what tell us about the individual ones? And also, I'd love to know about the individual ones, and also I'd love to know is there some kind of a recurring theme that goes through all of them, that threads them all together?

I do believe that all of them have led me to where I am today. I look back at them and say, okay, each one gave me a certain lesson, but it molded me into who I am. So if you can look at something that's tragic and look at the blessing that comes out of it, you might not see it right away. So my first NDE it was the same night that Princess Diana had her accident. First NDE it was the same night that Princess Diana had her accident. So I was a single mom and I was out with some friends and it was on the TV. So you're watching it and you can remember that impact like, oh, you know what about our children? So I remember, when it was time to go home. I had this premonition I didn't know what a premonition was at that time. It's like don't get in the car. So I was like I don't think I'm supposed to get in this car. My friends are like, oh, it's just because you watched that. You know, Princess Diana, and you're a single mom, just get in the car. And it was a two-door sports car freeway and we were in the slow lane and I felt something was going to happen. I felt like we were going to be hit. How I knew that, I do not know. It just came to me like you're going to be hit and at that moment I said no, no, no, I'm a single mom, please save us. And bam, we were hit by a big truck. You know one of those trucks that didn't have windows on the sides, and it came from the fast lane and just took us out. We spun out and took 40 feet of guardrail out and just came facing oncoming traffic but the car is squeezed there's. I don't even know how we even fit. I was in this little pocket but we couldn't get out. It was crushed. And so, all of a sudden, somebody came miraculously to our door, opened it effortless, carried each one of us to the embankment and I had this ring on my finger that was bent and it was a really strong ring. If you put all your weight on it, you can't bend it, and I was like it's crushing my finger. My finger is bleeding. Can you help me get this off? He took it and put it in his mouth, so I have his teeth rings to show he was real. But he kissed me on the forehead and said I will see you again, you will be fine. And he went to the left. But at that time all the fire trucks we had like three fire trucks we had ambulances, they were all coming to the scene to the right. So I went to look to the right. You know, that's just normal. When I went to left he was gone and no one ever seen him. So that led that whole thing. What was this person? What just happened? Why did I see that? How? You know all these questions.

And I started going to conferences during Virtue, Wayne Dyer and kind of learning, you know, about the afterlife. It opened that door again. And then, years later, when I was like a week after

I was proposed to to my former husband, but he, I was going to a friend's house and I was in a left turn bay just waiting to go into the neighborhood no premonition, no nothing. And a man had a diabetic seizure. The police were like following him, trying to get him off the road. I am what stopped him. And so he was going about 75, 80 miles an hour and he just rammed me. I didn't feel anything. I just was all of a sudden out of my body looking down at what was transpiring and I saw the car swirl and I saw like a big truck carrying tractor equipment coming and was going to go over me and crush me. At that same time I heard a strong voice behind me saying are you ready? And I said and I knew what that meant, that meant to stay here, to pass to transition. And I said no, no, no, no, no, no, life is too good, but I have three children, once again I need to go back. And before I said but I'm not going to survive that Before I knew it I had police at my door.

I was in once again, the back seat of my car. All windows were blown away, my four-door was now crushed into like a two-door. I was in once again the back seat of my car. All windows were blown away, my four-door was now crushed into like a two-door. And I can remember the police officer saying are you okay, are you okay? And I had a mouthful of glass. I couldn't speak. And then he looked at the gentleman next to me and he was like shaking. And he's like are you okay? He's like no, I don't know what just happened, but I should have crushed her.

I was driving that truck and something took my steering wheel and put me into oncoming traffic and at that moment it downloaded. I saw that. So you know, everybody's going to the ER, helicopter for Life is coming in for the other gentlemen and, um, I walked away. The hospital never checked for internal injuries, nothing. They're just like oh, you're fine, you can leave. I'm like, really, really. So I ended up having a neck injury for a little bit, but we, we were able to, um, get that fixed. But either way, that opened up my mediumship, because now I'm hearing spirit and I'm taken to a different place. Where is that place? Who was that? That was speaking to me, right, and so that opened that door.

And then, a few years later, I think the floodgates opened from when I was a child and I was just hearing and dabbling into the mediumship. And then I got tested at the. Well, it was the Veritas Center with Dr Kerry Schwartz and Dr Julie Beischel, which is now the Windbridge Center. But I had to use science to say is this real? Is what I'm getting real? Is you know? And be tested. And I think the science gave me that backbone to know like, okay, yes, what you're getting is absolutely a connection, a strong connection. So then we go to my third NDE, which this NDE.

I was sick and dying and doctors couldn't figure out what was wrong with me. I was at Mayo Clinic, being seen, going through every single test, and I was laying in a fetus position in bed just going. There's no quality of life. I've lost my dignity. I can't keep my bowels, I can't eat without any pain, I can't drink without any pain, and no one was finding anything. So I just started saying you know God, I'm ready. Which, if I think about it now, you know I had three grown children that were out of the house, but I still had a daughter that was in second grade. How do you, how do you say that? You know, but I was. I felt like this is no quality, not quality for my family, not quality for me.

And I remember one day, spiritual surgeons showing up in my room and I'm like well, I'm not afraid of them, right, because I see I'm a medium. So I'm like, all right, well, maybe they're here to work on me. Well, I remember the pain being super bad. I can remember them cutting open the right side and going in with a tube. And I can remember cutting open the right side and going in with a tube. And I can remember. I don't know if I can bear this pain, and so I was like, well, I can, I can do this, I'll just take my mind away from what's happening. And I took a deep breath and I was like, okay, just relax. When I took that deep breath, all of a sudden I extended and I went up out of my body and I just kept floating, like, well, this is nice, I don't have any pain. I like this, I'm good, all right.

So I get to a place where I feel like I'm where airplanes are. There's a whole bunch of clouds. I'm just on these clouds, I'm like I'm all alone. Okay, what's going to happen now? Now I see this beam of light coming towards me and it felt so calming and so filled with love. I recognized that.

And now I remember seeing that, while I was looking, this beam of light turned into who, I say, is God. God comes in many forms, so I don't like to try to describe exactly what I see, because you may see something different, but he was holding me, he was carrying me this time and my ear was over his arms and I was like now I'm watching as a soul level, what's happening to my body, and so I follow and he takes my body and he puts it on a beam of light and there's a coffin next to it and I have to tell you, the coffin was really pretty like a snow white glass coffin. I'm like, do you think I could just like sit in there see what it's like? And I'm like, don't even ask, you probably shouldn't do that. So I wasn't even put two and two together, like you're going to have a choice here, right? So I remember following him and like where are we going? So I remember following him and like where are we going to this dome. I said, why do we have to go in this dome? It was full of questions and it's like, because what I'm going to say to you is only for you, I don't want the universe to hear it. So it was like we're going to be into this space.

And while we were there, we were having a conversation and the conversation led me to sit down at a table and I saw my Lifeline contract. I couldn't see anything from this day forward. It stopped, and so I was told I needed to come back with a new mission. And I'm like, well, what's that mission? And I saw some words. One was prosperity, one was voice. One was voice. One was, you know, healthy. And so I was like, okay, voice means mediumship, I can do that. And it realized health not only meant me but to heal others.

So, on the bottom line, it's like you need to sign this because you were living on borrowed time and now you're going to go back, but I want you to remember this day and you're taking the oath, and so it was 121.12 and all those numbers are reversible. He says remember this, everything is reversible. And so when you're hearing this, nothing's really you're downgrading it, but you don't really understand it all right. So I said, well, can I see my parents while I'm here? Like I'd really love to see them, or some loved ones you know, come on. And I was like, no, no, you can't, because then you'll never leave, you can't see anyone. That was not why I was there.

And so God signed the line too, which really made an impact for me later in life, because I had to make some really hard choices and I knew that, okay, I'm not doing this, I'm making this choice by myself. Now, I didn't instantly heal, it wasn't like I came back, surgery's done, everything's fine. It took about six months, and I really spent that time loving my body and writing things down in a journal like is there something that I'm holding onto that needs to be released? And there was. And so I worked on that. But then all of a sudden, I was feeling that as I was healing myself, I was learning how to heal. And so now I'm like well, how does this work? And God led me each step of the way to show me that this is. God taught me how to heal and, through God, this is how these sessions work. So I can't say I take ownership, I'm just an instrument and vessel.

But when I presented this to my former husband, he said this is too big for me, I can't do the walk with you. And we were inseparable. We had a great marriage, great family, and people are

like, well, if you can't survive, like don't do the work, stay, don't do the work. But I made an oath and I knew God would have my back through it. So I had to lose everything. I owned my entire foundation.

I was scared because I was like, how am I going to eat? You know, how am I going to survive? I didn't do this as a work, so it's like now, what do I do? But I think that's why I had to be that way, so that God said no, this will become your work, this is your mission, and I'm going to walk you through each step of the way. And it took many years for it to build upon itself. But I never lost that faith and I knew that I made a commitment. But I also knew that I would always have what I need when I needed it, because I had God's back. And that's a big message for people Don't lose that hope, because you'll always have what you need when you need it.

And the first thing out of this guy's mouth, out of his spirit's mouth, was ask him about the turtle.
