Suzanne, welcome back girl, I'm so thrilled to have you back on the show. Thank you, Julie. It's been a while, but we've seen each other in the meantime.

I know it. I know we like get an air kiss in the passing, usually at the Helping Parents Heal conferences. Yes. Which are so, my gosh, what an organization and I know you've been involved since the beginning and such a huge part of that. I'm honored to have one tiny little place to be a part of it.

I understand. Congratulations are in order for you, my girl. I have to read this because I'm not going to remember all of it. Everybody. Suzanne was recently honored with the Humanities Team Spiritual Leaders Award. Past recipients are Nelson Mandela and Archbishop Desmond Tutu. Pretty Heidi company there, girl Humbling, and alongside Pope Francis and the Dalai Lama, Suzanne's also on the Watkins list of the 100 most spiritually influential living people. I love that.

That's how we get to add new people to the list. Unfortunately, somebody passes across the veil. They can add new people. I love it.

A former Navy commander with a master's degree in national security affairs. Suzanne served as a commanding officer and aide to the chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff. She's authored 15 books and created videos and recordings reaching millions worldwide. I'm so sorry you're such an underachiever.

But seriously, thank you for your service, both in the military and also to humanity at large in helping really change the zeitgeist. I think of the spiritual discussion. I'm seeing it in the work that I do and I have to assume you are as well that we've really seen a shift. You've been at it much longer than I have, but just in the time that I've been involved it's pretty dramatic. I think I wouldn't say pretty, it's very dramatic. Would you agree with that? Wonderful.

It's wonderful how open people are. They don't automatically say, oh, that's woo-woo. They want to know more or they're already on the path.

Yeah, yeah, and I use woo-woo. You gave me grief about that a lot of years ago and what I found out is woo in Taoism is source, woo means source, so they call it the woo-gee, the woo, whatever, wow. So I didn't know. That's where the woo-woo came from.

And somebody I know knows that I like to make acronyms out of everything and they said woo-woo is window of opportunity, window of opportunity. There you go.

That works good too. How'd you go from being a naval officer into becoming a medium?

When I saw the lifeless body of my stepdaughter at her funeral, I had a knowing that I couldn't describe that there is more, that she still has to exist in some form. I had synchronistically been led to a book about mediums about four weeks before she passed. That opened my mind to possibilities and looking at her body I said I'm going to find her spirit.

Well, and I think I have goosebumps listening to you talk about that, but I also believe that you were led when you were still in the military. Please tell everybody about when you were an aide to the chairman of the Joint Chiefs on 9-11 of 2001, when terrorists attacked the World Trade Center and the Pentagon, and I believe that was all part of your journey leading up to all of this.

It definitely started me asking the deep spiritual questions about why are some people in the wrong place at the wrong time? Allegedly, I had no concept of a bigger picture or eternal life, and we left the Pentagon on a Sunday morning, took off in an airplane headed for Europe. We were over the Atlantic when we got news about what we thought was a small plane crashing into the World Trade Center. And then, when we found out it was not an accident and it wasn't a small plane, the chairman told me to have the pilot take us back to Washington. And I went up to the cockpit and I said we're going back and he looked at me and he said Commander, our flight path is going to take us right over Manhattan. By the time we got over Manhattan, every other aircraft in all of US airspace had been grounded, but because we had the leader of the United States Armed Forces on board, the chairman, we had fighter escorts all the way back to Washington, so it would have been the last passenger jet because obviously those fighters were in the air. And we landed and went back to the Pentagon and stood there staring at this hole in our building that we had just left and all I could think was those were people just

like us sitting at their desks that this is just this hole. Right now. I stepped over jet engine pieces in the grass I didn't know how to process that or my grief.

I had no coping tools. I had no religion, no spirituality, nothing. So I pretty much ran away from all of that. I put in my retirement papers, wasn't eligible for two more years, but I just bided my time and then took off, literally sailed off into the sunset with my husband to just go live our dream. And then, while we were out cruising, we sailed across the Atlantic. Big adventure. But life caught up with us, with my stepdaughter's death.

And you had to come back from overseas.

Oh yeah, that was the whole time we were traveling back in such despair and I thought back to when I was an escort officer for the families of 9-11 for the memorial service. I volunteered for that duty. They needed people to escort the victims' families and I realized then that was a huge mistake on my part because I couldn't handle their grief. I just, I was raised where you feel everything positive, you know you're only happy. I never saw my mother cry, but then when Susan died, that was up close and personal and we couldn't run away. But that was a turning point that just propelled me on this journey. And now I see that Susan is still with us, as my heart knew, and other people's loved ones are still with us. It was my search to connect with her soul that opened me up to a whole world I didn't even know existed.

Well, and for you to go through the whole 9-11 thing in such a close and personal way. I know a retired colonel Air Force colonel that was there that day too and was actually the aid to the Secretary of the Air Force at the time. And whenever I hear somebody say, well, that didn't really happen, that was just CGI and all that, I think I know two people that were there.

Oh yes, and to have, like I said, to step over engine pieces to smell the fuel. There's no explaining that away. And you were in the building too, right?

Yes, I was right there Because your general wanted to go inside the building and I remember you telling me you were thinking why are we inside here Well we went to his office, which was on the far side where the attack was.

But he wanted to see the impact site, which was on the other side. So we started going through the center. We were going to come at the impact from behind. The electricity was out, there's smoke everywhere and I'm thinking why are we inside? Smoke everywhere and I'm thinking, why are we inside? And happily his bodyguard at that point said let's go outside, sir. And we stepped out into this soggy grass and it was just life-changing.

God bless you. And then please share with everybody how Susan passed, because that also is a remarkable story.

It is. She was a sergeant in the Marines just pretty recently, seven months earlier, married to another Marine, she had volunteered to go to Iraq as a Marine and her husband said no, susan, it's too dangerous, stay here. So she stayed there. One day she was reporting for duty. There was a storm about 10 miles away but a bolt of lightning came down where she was and struck her and they worked on her for seven hours and couldn't save her or the little boy she was carrying, her baby. That would have been our only grandchild and it took them both that day. Yeah, yeah.

So obviously those were too dramatic, to say the least, life altering experiences to shake you up, to get you to the place where you said, okay, wait a minute, there's more to the story here to the place where you said, okay, wait a minute, there's more to the story here.

Well, there's a third. Okay, what's the third? I started reading about these people who could allegedly talk to those who have passed mediums and I determined I'm going to take my husband, we're going to find a medium. We're not going to give them our last name so they can't look us up online, know anything about us. And I found somebody who I knew had the ability to see spirits. She showed it to me in a way that she didn't realize. She was revealing something in a class we were both in and I took my husband, didn't tell her what we wanted and she says there's a young girl here who died rather suddenly in her 20s, and she's wearing a brown uniform. And I have this tingly electrical feeling running up and down my body and I suddenly have the headache of Zeus and Athena, zeus being the god of lightning bolts. There was nothing about that that she could have known. And then she described her personality. She described the way she was sitting next to her dad, which was exactly how Susan used to drape herself across my husband's tie. And the clincher the world-rocking knock-yourself-off clincher was when she said and there's a little baby boy with her that she wants to introduce to you. And it was a boy she was going to have.

I was sobbing. I was like it's real, I knew it. I knew she's here. This was a year after she passed. I'd been meditating every day, trying to connect with her myself. This just cemented my awareness that she is here and I'm going to get her myself, and I just stayed with that practice. She deliberately held back, did not come through for three years because she knew if she'd come right away I would have said, susan, here you are, and stopped and going on to something else. But I was committed to connecting with her myself and in those three years I opened up to psychic abilities, other people's loved ones, other higher beings that I never knew were there or that I could possibly connect with. So it was a good practice.

And you and I both live in the deep south, and so down here they would tell us you were being led, darling.

Do you think now, knowing what you know and being able to communicate with spirit, do you believe that they're always communicating with us and it's up to us to be their receiver, to tune in to their frequency so that we can hear them and get their information, and see them and work with them?

I would just modify that a little. I wouldn't say they're always communicating with us. Depends on who you're talking about. They're always available. So I liken it to different stations on the radio or TV. Different stations are always right here. But another analogy is if we're talking about loved ones who have passed picture a family sitting on a couch in the living room and one person's watching TV, one person's reading, the other one's knitting they're not communicating, but they're all around each other and they know that. And then at some point somebody just speaks up and says something to the other. Then they look up and they engage and then they go back to doing their own thing.

It's like that, right right, and I picture that all of the satellite TV stations are all broadcasting their programming and it's for us to tune in to what programming it is we want to receive.

Because we're able to transmit and receive with spirit, but it's attention intention receive with spirit, but it's attention intention.

Where is your attention and what's your intention with where you want to put your attention? So I agree with that. In your newest book, Mediumship, you say you want people to know that their loved ones are still right here and want to communicate with them. I love the analogy of sitting on the couch knitting and they're around. But say more about that. How do people know that their loved ones are around? How do you know that their loved ones are around?

The book Mediumship. I take part one and I answer all of the. How does it work? What is it? Why do we do it? But part two consists of two of my evidence-based stories and 30 stories from contributors who are normal people who've had interactive experiences with loved ones who have crossed, many of which fall in the category of ADCs after-death communications. So I love that this book opens us up to the wide range of ways that those across the veil get through to us. For me, mediumship in the strictest sense of the word is sitting with a medium who acts as an intermediary, a voice for those across the veil. But mediumship is also sacred communications from loved ones personally. So they might flicker your lights or they might leave a sign that's undeniable that they led you to know that they're right here, that sort of thing.

And most people discount that because they don't know that it really is their loved one and they're thinking there's no way that I can figure out how to make that something that's really that I can validate. What do you say to those people?

I say to that that there is a quality to those true ADCs after death communications that you know in your heart. That was them. That was not a coincidence, that's not an accident. In my book, messages of Hope, I give the three examples of signs that Susan gave us in the first week after she passed, two of which had to do with butterflies acting in very unusual ways. No other explanation moments is what I call it an N-O-E, and so to this day if we see a butterfly we think of Susan because of those astounding moments. But we know that that's not an A-D-C. There's something timely about them, astounding and you know in your heart because you have that heart-to-heart connection with them.

And it's the first thought that comes into their heads. That's what I teach is look, you're talking to your deceased grandmother's spirit in heaven and you say something to her and you're going to get something in your head immediately, sometimes before your thought to her is even completed. And that's because time doesn't exist in the spirit world. Time's a human creation.

She's already got your thought and she's responding, but we're all taught, especially in the Western world, to overanalyze the daylights out of everything, and that's why part of the teaching in my classes consists of telling you to notice that thinking, when thinking takes place first of all, you kind of stop breathing when you're really thinking hard and you feel as if you're perceiving the world from the head. But you can intentionally move awareness down into the center of you, into the heart space. But I'm not talking about the emotional heart that opens and closes. I'm talking about just this state of being that's very peaceful and perceived from here and thinking ceases just long enough for you to notice unusual things that stand out that are arising in awareness, not in the head.

In the field of awareness Right, I have a friend named Son Ching, who's a Taoist priest, and he says if you're thinking, you're not knowing. If you're knowing, you're feeling. And I think that's exactly what you're talking about. That it's a feeling that you get. It reminds me of children's little chunky puzzles, you know with the big wooden pieces, and you put that last piece in and it kind of clunks into place and it fits.

0:18:33 - Julie You know it's there.

0:18:35 - Suzanne

Yeah, I tuned in before reading the other day and before I even shifted my awareness, I tuned into Zoom and my client is there and her daughter in spirit showed me a white lamb. I hadn't even asked her to step in yet she's showing me this white lamb. Then, when I asked her to step in, she showed it to me again and that came with that clunk, that knowing she used to have a stuffed white lamb and it carries the message that I'm held in the arms of God and protected mom. And she did. Her mom confirmed very first stuffed animal she had as a baby was a white man.

How sweet is that.

Why is it that, when we can get what you call evidential information from our loved ones, certainly it helps our loved ones still here in human form process that. Okay, this spirit is really around me, because there's no way Suzanne would know this. There's no way that Julie would know this. I've seen research that shows that that's the best, perhaps most effective way to heal grief is to communicate with a loved one in spirit.

What are your thoughts on that? I haven't heard it put in that much of a definitive term. The best way, I would say it's right up there with the best ways, because you can't get your loved ones back and we know that. But when we think they're dead and gone, which people say all the time, or I've lost my loved one, to find out they're not really gone. They're actually here,

right here in awareness different channel, like we said gone. They're actually here, right here in awareness different channel, like we said, and we can still communicate with them and we get to say the things we didn't get to say and hear the things we wanted to know from them. That really changes everything and that we don't need a medium to do that. The communication is ongoing, right.

Right? Well, you and I both, I think are of the mind that you can give somebody a fish, or you can teach them to fish, and so we both are of the mindset of let's teach whoever how to do this, anybody that's interested. It's not hard. Everybody has the ability. It's just a matter of developing and enhancing it. Would you agree?

with that I would, and I heard an even more meaningful for this field that you and I are in analogy the other day. You can save a drowning person or teach them to swim, so fishing is nice We've heard that before but these are drowning people. They're drowning in their grief. I love that, yeah isn't that great.

0:21:15 - Julie Yeah, that is good.

I was talking with a client this morning for the first time and her three daughters.

Her husband had passed a couple of months ago and so her three adult daughters were there and it was lots of stuff came through through, but the thing that I thought was the best was he was a farmer and he coached his kids and his grandkids basketball teams, you know, just as a parent and a grandparent.

And so they said well, does he have anything that he wants to say about basketball? Because apparently he had played basketball in high school and college. And so he was talking about a couple of plays, like the play when you throw the ball all the way down the court and you got somebody down there to receive the ball while the other team is still running down the court and you've already made a basket, and they knew what that was. But the funniest part, Suzanne, was he said the most important thing with these kids, whether they're little or whether they're in high school, is they have to have fun, or whether they're in high school, is they have to have fun. We get so stressed out about it and we put so much pressure on these kids that it's crazy, because when somebody is under pressure, they can't perform.

Doesn't that work in our field too? Exactly as teachers, people get so stressed I've got to get it right. When it's surrendering and just allowing this connection unfold makes for the best connection.

So he was going on and on about how you have to have fun you know, that's the most important thing and his family was laughing. They said, oh my God, he was the most stressed out coach ever in the history of basketball coaches. And they said he certainly has a different perspective from heaven. And I think that that's really true. I'm sure you've run into that a lot of times too. Is there something that comes to mind?

I had one where a mother in spirit showed me that she didn't believe and she also showed me she had terrible eyesight and she said tell my daughter, I can see clearly now but there's a double meaning and her daughter burst into tears and said that was our song.

I love that. Yeah, I can hear it in my head. How do non-physical interactions occur? How does spirit communicate? How does one get information? Do they ask specifically for send me something that's going to be something that I can't deny, to let me know that it's really you with whom I'm talking. You know if it's a loved one or a friend or whomever. How do spirits communicate?

first of all, you mean with anyone or through a medium? Yeah, both. Well, they manipulate consciousness to put information into our field of awareness, and that can come through visuals. You can see images in your mind's eye. You can hear thoughts that may sound like your own, but it's coming from spirit. There's that knowing. Or they catch our attention with things in the objective world, like they snag your attention when you look at the clock and it says 444, and that was your number together. They snag your attention by flicking the lights and you know it's them. So this can be an inner experience and awareness or something in the objective world.

I find that they communicate in symbols and signs, and also in words and phrases as well. Why do you think they communicate that way?

0:25:11 - Suzanne

That's how we perceive the world, but the better and more attuned the medium is, they don't even need to use words. I brought through astronaut Edgar Mitchell, who was the first man to walk on the moon and started the Institute of Noetic Sciences. Twelve days after he passed, a dear friend of his said do you think you can get Edgar? Well, we got great evidence that showed it was him. They were friends. He recognized his personality. That was not what we expected, not what I expected, certain things that he had in his home. But then he started.

Edgar started transmitting information to me in bursts, no words, just here's what I want you to share. And then I've sent it back to him in a burst. I didn't say words, I just, in one download, sent him back a communication. And Edgar said to me what we're doing is like passing a hockey puck of information back and forth, and the hockey is significant. It's a current event. I shared this whole thing with my client and he said I hate sports, but last night I had a house guest. We went to a hockey game and I was sitting in the stands watching it and just daydreaming about Edgar. So he imparted a whole message about how this communication actually can take place beyond our normal speaking, and then a current event for the client, which is really cool yeah.

I agree. I find too that when I'm traveling internationally in a country where I don't speak the language you know, signs and symbols are the universal language, even for spirit. So if I'm looking for the ladies room, I'm looking for a picture of the toilet or I'm looking for a picture of you know that women's symbol that usually is associated with a restroom.

Excuse me, in one of my classes I had a guy that swam in your world. He was a contractor engineer who did black ops, so you know I always tease him. I say, yeah, you could tell me about it, but you'd have to kill me first, right that's the old joke yeah.

So he wanted, he was working on some algorithm for something and he wanted to talk to Einstein. So we pulled Einstein in and Einstein was relaying these mathematical equations and things, equations and things to my guy way above my pay grade. I mean, I about broke out in hives when I saw those mathematical equations, but I was telling, I was able to write them down and I was telling them what they were and it was fascinating to watch them solve this algorithm problem, whatever that my client was working on together.

That is really good Wild. And then recently in one of my trainings I had a research scientist from Harvard that's working on cancer research and it involves vitamin C and she wanted to talk to Linus Pauling, who won, you know, the Nobel Prize for curing polio with vitamin C. And I think those are great examples that you and I have witnessed ourselves of the availability of anybody. In spirit, you can talk to anybody you want, whether you knew them or not.

That's right. They won't always come through if it's for your ego, but if it's helpful in healing, yeah, they'll help you yeah it's amazing.

Awakened Way, you share practical tools we can use to live a divinely guided life. What's a divinely guided life? What's that look like?

Oh, what it looks like is you stop worrying, you stop planning. You basically say guide me, lead me, show me what to do next, and you don't have to ask all the time. You just have it's like your ear is, as often as you can remember, tuned in to do next, and you don't have to ask all the time. You just have it's like your ear is, as often as you can remember, tuned in to higher guidance and you just get in this state of flow. I have a course coming up with the Shift Network, all about this how mediumship opens you to a life of flow because you're consciously connected, not just when you're doing readings, as you know, but all the time. I used to be a planner and have to-do lists and I just don't anymore. My biggest goal is just to be guided by spirit.

Well, and that's a big shift for you and for me, because of what we did, you know, before we learned how to do this stuff, for heaven's sake. As a naval officer, I mean, your life was guided by routine and rules and regulations, and orders yes ma'am Stuff like that. Did it take you some time to relax into that and I'm sure it felt weird to you for a long time.

It did, and that's what I tell all my students. This is a journey, it's a process. It did and that's what I tell all my students. This is a journey, it's a process, and what we're doing is undoing patterns of left brain activity, getting more into balance with the right brain, because we still need the left brain but also gaining trust. We need to trust that the spirit world is real and that it's made up of sentient beings who are here to help us and we're part of that.

You have an inner nudge, you follow it, you act on it. It turns out to have some wondrous result that wouldn't have happened otherwise and you say, wow, let's do that again. You can ask for signs along the way. If this is really you, what sign am I going to see today? I've had so many examples of that. I gasp all the time when I get my sign and my husband has stopped saying what? Because he knows I'm about to explain. You won't believe. I just got my sign.

Yeah, and he's a naval officer too. So when you took him to see the medium after Susan passed, I can't even imagine what he was thinking. Oh my God, my wife's lost her ever-loving mind.

Well, Julie, it's hilarious because he told me years later he didn't even know what a medium was. He just went along because he wanted to say yes, dear, but now he's married to one. I had no idea this was my path.

Right or how it was going to unfold, or have a plan on how for all of it to manifest. And you know we're so used to setting goals and having measurables, and all of that In nine companies I've founded. I've never done anything without a business plan, ever.

Oh yeah, yeah, I used to teach that too. I used to teach strategic planning, and it doesn't get any more rigid than that. Wow. And now people say what's your long-term goal? I said listen to spirit and serve. I know.

Me too, people go. What are you going to do with this? I say I don. I know Me too, people go. What are you going to do with this? I don't know. Well, why are you doing this? Again, I'm being led to serve, I'm being led to teach this stuff. Tell us about Sanaya.

All this first, 2010, sitting in meditation, a masculine and feminine energy, powerful, just settled over me and I said who are you? And they said we are a collective consciousness of your guides and you will write and write and write as Sanaya the name that I'd heard before reading a book by somebody named Sanaya. But why that name came to me? Why they gave it to me? Well, I looked it up after that meditation and it means one worth listening to and flash of lightning, oh Wow. And so I did.

I wrote their messages daily, daily, daily, until they started speaking through me, and I'm still, to this day, able to channel their messages. And we have an Awakened Way app. People can find it by typing in Awakened Way, with probably close to 6,000 of the daily messages now new ones every morning and a little oracle button. That's really helpful when you have a question for Spirit. You just tune into your heart and say give me a message from these archives. That's going to be the perfect answer for me now and you push the button. It stuns me how perfect they are.

Every morning I come up to this room, I sit down. I usually listen to meditation music, often with binaural beats. I have six of my own hemi-sync recordings.
