Thank you, it is from Welcome Back, Carter. Yeah, I remember that show.

My friend Alex Ferrari always says returning champion, so I can say that about you. We had you on a bit ago and it was so much fun and I got a Christmas present that you helped facilitate. That I want to talk about in a couple of minutes. But first you say love never dies. What do you mean by that?

I mean, love is the fabric of existence. It is the very nature of who we are, what we are, where we are, how we are. And even when our loved ones depart, as you know, they pack up that love and it's just, if not transmuted, it is amplified and the way in which we connect to the love may change. We may have to learn a few new tricks of the trade to connect with spirit, but the love is always there and I kind of see it as this beautiful current or wave, you know, when you are out on some hot pavement and someone throws some water down and you have that kind of ooey mist effect coming up. That's how I see love. It's just all around us like that and it never goes away. It just can't the sheer nature of it, it does not die.

You have a team of multidimensional guides in the angelic realm, as well as the seventh and ninth dimensions. Please tell us how you met and now work with them, and what happened to the eighth dimension. Is there not an eighth dimension?

That's a fantastic question so how I met them. They all filtered in at different times throughout my life. The angelic realm was probably the easiest for me to connect to around. I mean, I've had guides my entire life, whether or not they self-identified, kind of where they ranked or where they dialed in multidimensionally. That came later in life. So the angels came around pretty early in my 20s and made it very clear through some messages and the constant

repetition of the number 91-11, which matches Psalm 91-11. I don't remember if we even talked about that story.

What happened was I had just switched apartments because my apartment had been robbed and I lived at that time on the first floor. And I wanted to switched apartments because my apartment had been robbed and I lived at that time on the first floor and I wanted to go up because I thought, well, I'll at least give them a challenge. If anybody wants to come back, they'll have to walk up some steps.

So I was adjusting to this new place and still in that kind of fight or flight mode of being a victim of a crime, and came in from work one day and back when we had answering machines, the light on the answering machine was blinking like I had a message, but the number of messages said zero. So it was a little strange and at that time you could also pick up the phone and you heard multiple beeps if you had a voicemail. And I heard the beeps, so I called the voicemail and I heard the beeps. So I called the voicemail and it was this extremely distraught, eerie, ghost-like male voice that was kind of whispery and said help me, over and over and it was very freaky. Now I've seen you know dead people, I talked to guides and all of that, but still that was a bit much for me Still coming off of the robbery, and I'm like, okay, I'm not liking this life so much right now. It's a little scary.

But after I settled my nerves for a minute I thought I need to call the. I don't know why I thought this. I need to call this person back because if he was trying to reach a family member or somebody that really did need help, I need to let him know he didn't get the right person. So I dialed the number back star 69, like you could do back then, and the only thing I received was a different voice that just said he shall give his angels charge over thee to keep thee in all thy ways, psalm 91, 11.

It wasn't. Hey, it's Bob, leave me a message. It was just that, and I think at that point I threw my phone across the room because I always just hear many weird things at once, and then I tried to call back again. I thought did I make that up? Same message Over the course of like the next week to two weeks. Anytime I would call this number. I would get the message and it never beeped like you could leave a voicemail, it was just the outgoing message message. What's fun is I would ask my friends to call. Hey, you tried, they would call and it would just ring I would call and I would get the message.

so I thought, okay, something, something's going on. Angels char give, give his angels charge over the 91 11. Then I started seeing the number 91-11 everywhere. It would be on the receipt that I got at the store. It would be something on a computer screen. There was a point in this kind of period of two to three months where I could go to a bookstore or a library, pick any book in any area, any genre, flip it open and something on the page would have 91-11. It would be like the table number from a chart or it would be like it was everywhere. One day I was driving down the road and saw a book kind of overturned in the middle of the road and I just felt the nut. I mean it's going to be in that book, it's going to be in that really random book on the side of the road and stopped my car. There was no traffic. I wasn't quite that excited to find the synchronicities in the messages, but I got it on Sure Enough.

No, I had gotten so many it's like I don't even need this validation, but I'll go and Sure Enough, it was in that book. So that was how I met the angelic realm, a little dramatically, but from that period of time I understood the way in which they communicated but also like the different bandwidth or the different frequency that they would come in. That was different from the quides that I had known. I kind of call like my regular quides. You know how you have regular plates and silverware and then you have like the fancy company the angels are like the China, the expensive silverware and plates and things servings, and my regular guides just felt different. So for a number of years I worked with the angelic realm primarily, and then, I don't know, seven or eight years ago or so now, the galactic started to come in and that was more of a physical experience because my frequency needed to raise higher than the angelic realm and that doesn't mean better, it's just a different wavelength in order to connect in an extended period of time. So I went through a lot of physical experiences of being extremely exhausted and then wide awake for days and that would kind of dip and come in and out of that and had an experience of witnessing a craft, had some fun things in my driveway happen, with messages and orbs and things being arranged in a way to answer questions that I had. I don't know why my team has to be so dramatic all the time, but so that's how I met the Galactics and that is where some of my art comes from now. So I think they were coming on board when it was time for me to kick that off.

And as far as the eighth dimension, I really don't know. No one really talks about it, do they? I know the fourth is kind of the pass-through. As I understand it and as it's been explained to me, the fourth is kind of the pass-through from third-dimensional reality to fifth, where it's dreams and it's almost like the island of lost toys, of dimensions. It's all the weird stuff kind of lives in there as we're passing through. So maybe the eighth is like that, between the seventh and ninth floors of the hotel as I like to see them.

He was hoping they were going to come in and join his side. They will override your answer yeah, exactly.

I'm thinking where do you think I'm getting this guidance from? You know, from the spirits and beyond, but like he was ever denied anything, I mean, please, he's an only child, center of the universe, right? We refer? To him as his majesty even now. Couple of points, and I want to get into the galactic thing. When you first started talking about connecting with your angels, my clock said 3. Three in the Bible is the number for divine perfection. That struck me too.

But there was the shape of a branch in a question mark and then the point of the question mark was like an acorn or a rock or something big in my driveway a question mark with a little point. And when I went inside I said this is too good, I have to go get a camera or my phone or whatever it was I used at the time when I came back out and took the picture. There's four different orbs in the picture.

Wow, so that was the galactic team, and I always feel like I need like a little drum roll or something after this. So maybe it takes a lot to get my attention and that's why things have to do that. But I also love I love synchronicities and I love things like that and I love exploring the boundary of reality and how we're all learning to make these different connections across time and space and dimension and all the things. So it gets to be really fun when you chase things down like that. But that's my driveway story.

So the craft you said? It looked like a blue orb. Do you think that's what it was? It was a spacecraft.

Well, it's interesting too when you are describing it as an orb, because when you were describing what was happening in your driveway with the snow, I'm thinking it was almost like you were inside a snow globe because it didn't go anywhere around you, it was only in your enclosed environment, like a snow globe.

And I think even just my backyard which is fenced in and not even in the front. But I don't remember that part specifically, I just remember it. And they were giant snowflakes. They were so odd and fluffy and very Truman Show actually.

Wow, interesting. Okay, so your guides that are galactic? Tell us about them. How do you know they're galactic? Does that mean that they live on other planets? They originated from other planets? All of the above, why galactic guides instead of guides that were human? Maybe these guys were human in different lifetimes, but why the differentiation?

I think the main reason for the differentiation is the frequency that they can hold and I call it the space pun intended that they inhabit. So the main group of guides that I and I've deemed them galactic because they've explained to me different origin points Right now in the work that we're doing together. They don't really inhabit any planet they shift into because they're pure light body, but they shift into a form and a way in which I can perceive them and communicate with them when it's time for us to do what it is, that we do our work together. But I think another reason is some of the art that I do and the sacred geometry connected to that is tied to some of the Arcturian lineage and their specialty is geometry and math and things that are kind of form-based and complex structures. So in order for them to transmit some of that to me when I drop into a channeled state to do the art, that's kind of where they come from.

It's just like having anybody that you would, I guess, hire for a team.

Everybody has their own specialty and their thing that they're strongest in, and so a lot of these galactic beings and there are many, they won't tell me how many. It's kind of like this, never ending. Well, if I ask for who needs to step forward with something, it may be somebody different every time, but in my perception of them they're all kind of in the same general area, like this disc kind of thing that almost floats. It's very Star Trek-y and spaceship-y, but there's just this never ending kind of line or crowd of them there available and I think also going along with all the consciousness work that we're doing on the planet right now, many more people are accessing these different frequencies. I want to say higher, but again, as humans we tend to think higher means better, because we like to go up the rung. It's just a different frequency in that kind of space, but I think it was primarily to connect with me for the art, and then it also turned into being channeled transmissions in that way.

I'm perceiving it as a different frequency, similar to. You want to listen to country music on 94.7. You want to listen to classic rock on 102.5.

You want to listen to classical music on 101.3. It's just a different channel that you're tuning to and that they all are spirit that can communicate with us, and one is not better than another. To your point, it's just for different things that you're looking for guidance on. When I'm working with people clients primarily who want to know who their spirit guides are, spirit guides all look to me like a version of father time. They look like old men with white hair, white beards and white gowns and they're various sizes, tall and thin, short and chubby, whatever. And then when we hone in on them and we say, okay, show us the lifetime in which you live that correlates the most with what Heather wants to explore here right now, then they'll morph into whatever and they'll look like humans or they'll look like I normally see humans.

I don't see a lot of aliens. I mean, I've seen past lives in different galaxies far, far away and on different planets and things. But normally I'll see spirit guides that are human at one point and they can range from, you know, looking like somebody's grandmother to I've seen a couple of times this guy that comes in Heather and he looks like the banker in Monopoly, the Monopoly game. I've seen Mary Kay Ash, you know, I've seen figures that are historic figures, both in business and commerce and in government Sam Walton, Abraham Lincoln, George Washington. You know different scientists, things like that and they appear to me in a way that I can recognize who they are, as they're telling me you know what their name is and then why they're advising my clients, so that makes total sense to me that you're doing that. What is speaking of your art? And I want to get into that in depth here in a minute but what's quantum mapping?

So quantum mapping is a technique that I'm going to say I channeled that as well, because I never sought it out. It's something that, as I would go to work with clients in an energy healing capacity for me, their energy would kind of organize itself in this distinct pattern, almost where it's a grid around their energy body, and I call them energy lay lines because they would have like different lines, would have a theme. I think most people by now are aware of the chakras and they all kind of are a CEO of their own area of the body and they work with different things. This took that and added to it a little bit. Where there might be a line that's related to past lives, there might be a line that's related to relationships, and then the intersection point of those might help me identify not just where in the body, because if you also can imagine that being overlaid over the form of a person standing in front of you, so often it points to a certain area of the body. It will like light up, like a light, bright board for me in that way, but then it's also giving a clue of where we can explore a certain theme with them. So that just kind of came during.

You know, I was doing kind of traditional Reiki and T-touch and other things and then just surrendering into working with clients remotely. I would start channeling sound and I would have an urge to do certain motions. I would bring other sounds in, like I needed to do chimes for this person or a drum for somebody else. I never asked to do any of that. I'm just sitting here on my couch, you know, trying to have a conversation with somebody, and all this other stuff wants to come in, and then that eventually went to. Let's organize it in this certain way. So, number one, we can be a little efficient with it, but number two, it can be kind of a pattern that I can go back to time and time again. It doesn't happen every time I work with someone, but it's something that I observed, noticed, went deep into to see what it could teach me and what I could gain from it, and then I've taught a couple of classes on it to help other healers as well.

So in that regard I always was kind of open in that and had that understanding Can you give us?

I joke that I probably stopped telling adults what happened because the plants in the yard would just say, hey, I'm like, basically I'm not poisonous. You can, you know, take a little piece of this leaf and taste this and see what that is for you. And they may have said at the time you know, this would be good for a fever or a rash or whatever it was. But can you imagine, as a mom, your child just outside munching on plants, you know, not knowing what they are Like? I'm sure I got in trouble for that, for doing it.

And I remember the horses across the street that our neighbor owned would be boarded at like a barn during the week sometimes, and when they would come back to live on their property, I would sneak over. I wasn't supposed to leave the yard, but I snuck over to see the horses and would feed them grass. And I had this understanding of them saying no, that grass over there would be better and we would like that instead. And then they would tell me, like the gossip from the barn where they were, like what, like, what?

the people were doing I can't believe what this person did and this horse has like such an attitude and I listened to them like I was listening to adults having a conversation.

So my family was always very supportive of those topics in general. We would watch documentaries on mediumship and spiritual things, but also we would watch Nova and nature and all the science-based stuff. It, but also we would watch Nova and Nature and all the science-based stuff. And because my sister who had cerebral palsy, we had kind of a unique way of understanding communication because we knew what she wanted and she was nonverbal, so I think we were a little bit more understanding of it's not just language that connects us and there's something that goes deeper, in a way that you can understand a soul and understand a person. So we had that as well.

But I also went to Catholic school and it wasn't really something I would openly go and chat about, because the first couple of times I did I was the weird girl that nobody wanted to hear from and don't tell me I would go to class and tell somebody hey, john, I had a dream that you were going to cheat on this math test and the teacher found out about it. So you probably don't want to do it. Nobody wanted to hear that from me, so I would have kids. Tell me please don't dream about me, heather. And I wasn't controlling it, it was just what I was observing. So I kind of shut it down for a long period of time because I wanted to be normal and I wanted to fit in, as everybody does.

But then, you know, around my 20s I started getting more and more interested and was always, even though I wasn't speaking about it to other people and I didn't have anybody in my direct life who had any similar experiences. So I and I loved the commonalities between all of the religious doctrines where essentially we're all reaching for the same thing. It's to me it always felt very much like how you explained different frequencies. It was like, well, I want to reach God, I want to reach enlightenment, I want to have a good life. If you tune to this dial, you get Buddhism. If you turn to this dial, you get Hinduism.

Everybody was saying the same thing, in my interpretation as a teenager anyway, and then when I would look at the different ways like mystics or saints in the Catholic tradition, they were all having these very fascinating, interesting experiences and I remember feeling a little bit like well, what makes that so special? Like why is that celebrated in this timeline? But kind of not talked about now where I am? Because in my small town library all of the books on mediumship and animal communication and ghost hunting, they were right next to the occult and they were right in front of the librarian's desk so anybody who checked them out was under close observation and watch and it was just this weird vibe and more often than not the books would get checked out and nobody would bring them back because they were just like I'm not going to be known for taking this back or we couldn't get them anywhere else.

I don't know what it was, but there was just a small group of them, and it was interesting how those were the ones that were kind of, for some reason, oddly, kept and supervised in that way.

Interesting. So do you think we're all born with intuition? And if so, how can we validate it? How can we trust it?

Oh, that's a great question and that's something that adults to this day, of all ages, are frequently trying to say. How do I know that? It's my intuition and I didn't make something up. I do think we all are born with it to a degree. I think it is a little bit like any skill so playing a piano and anybody can kind of learn chopsticks, or you can learn a simple tune. Are you going to go

to carnegie hall and perform with an orchestra? There's a very select group of people who develop it to that ability. So I think it's a little bit of your aptitude for it and your determination to develop it.

But I think inherently, as humans, yes, we have intuition.

I think often we are persuaded or somehow made to feel that it is unnatural because we should prove things, we should have something in writing, we shouldn't go look for question marks made out of branches in our driveway and get really excited about that, and so, little by little, logic becomes the main way in which we are accepted, the main way in which we are approved, the main way in which we communicate, and then our gut instinct, which is the same as intuition, gets deprioritized, which then makes us trust it less and less because it's a muscle we aren't really using. So I think validating it for yourself or kind of learning to trust it again, takes a lot of practice. It takes a lot of courage and it takes the understanding of how it comes through for you. That's the other thing. Everybody experiences it a little bit differently, so it's good to explain and expand your awareness into how it could work, but then you really have to dial into your own experience of it and learn to trust yourself in that way.

The more validation you get, the more you trust it, and then it's just second nature. Yeah, do you walk around with your radar on all the time, or do you turn it on and off at will?

Oh gosh, no, no, I'll say I have like a radar light. Maybe I'm plugged into the world in what I feel is an expanded way, but am I super open and out about every little thing that's going on? No, for a couple of reasons. Number one I want to protect my energy, and that would drain me too much. Number two I'm here to be human too, so I don't always want the answers at the back of the book and yeah, I just.

I also think there's an etiquette to it as well. I don't want to unless somebody asks for my assistance with something I don't want to just like. That's one of the lessons I learned with the kid in school or kids in school when I would say don't cheat on that test or don't ask that girl out or whatever. It's not appropriate to just blurt that out with somebody unless they are really open to it. So I had to learn that through rejection a lot and now it's just. You know, I like to know and have an awareness of more than just my physical senses. So I expand out in that way, but then super open not unless I'm doing my work and connecting with somebody.

And then, as I grew up, I did charcoal, sketching and things like that and took a couple art classes in college but left it there, never really did anything else with it for a number of years and I just felt this calling like, oh, I miss that. I want to do that so badly but I didn't really, because I hadn't done it in so long, I didn't really know what to do, and so I was just playing with all these different ideas and around that same time the transmissions for what became one of my books started coming through in dreams and the way I would receive, like the topic in the chapter, it came with a picture that looked like a meme that represented whatever we're talking about. Like one of them is tune out to tune in, and so I would see like this cartoon TV, and I thought, well, and the pictures would not go away, and it's almost like I couldn't get to the message until I acknowledged the picture and I thought, am I supposed to draw these? Like? I don't know. So I started playing around with a digital art application for the purpose of illustrating the transmissions that were coming through to go with the stuff in my book.

And then I had done that for a number of weeks and was just doodling when this other stuff started coming out that looked like geometry and color and shape and form and I thought, hmm, it felt like something. I had no idea what. There's where we get to trusting your intuition. It felt different and that was the only clue that I had and I thought, okay, I also felt different when I did it. I would feel lighter, my energy felt more vibrant. I felt like I was at a different frequency and I could sketch like that and realize that I wasn't even present in the sketching. I was kind of channeling what was coming through. So I started playing around with it and somehow came to the awareness that, like I would, for instance, talk to a friend on the phone, be sketching while I was chatting with her, and then realize I just sketched her energy and I still didn't know what that meant.

That was the feeling I got and I did enough of them that I got a group of my friends together, showed them all that I had done, had like a little mini art show online and said I think these are each of you, can you pick your own out and, can you like, pick each other's out. And we were just, as everyone will see in a second, it was really just a geometric shape with color. It wasn't like I was drawing somebody's face or their profile and they were able to determine who was who and whose there were. Was that even the right way to say that? And they also said I don't know why, but I hear my name called from like a higher being, a higher source, or I feel like I want to cry, I feel like my heartbeat I feel a rush. They would have very visceral reactions to these.

Were these woo-woo people? Were they just spirituality or they were like just regular.

0:37:55 - Heather

Some of my normie friends who tolerate me when I'm like you know, if you're a chef, you probably like have the friends that you're like. I tried a new recipe. You know, here it is. That's my friends with some of my stuff. So, no, they were open to it, but they were not in the woo-woo camp so they weren't like wired to receive things in that way. And then from there I thought, well, I want to use, I feel like I've been given this or I've been shown this in a way that needs to serve somebody, needs to be an offering for somebody, because if that can help, whatever that was that experience they were having when they would see their own portrait. It was pretty powerful and I thought I want to give that to other people because it seems like I'm supposed to. And again, I was just trusting my intuition and so I expanded out to other clients I had at the time. Hey, would you want to do this thing? And then it got to be I would do one for somebody. They would show somebody at the chiropractor's office and then that person would contact me and it just kind of grew from there until I went a little bit larger with it.

But during that time of kind of ramping it out with a smaller base of people, my team kind of finally clued me in because I don't think they were going to until I really went for it that these are energetic signatures of our soul and this is coming in now into the world and I'm sure I'm not the only one who does something like this because as we are ascending, as our consciousness is expanding, we're getting to understand each other in these subtle energy ways.

Just like we would wear a name tag that would say, hello, my name is Julie or hi, my name is Heather. This is also a way of identifying us as a more expanded version of ourselves, and so, within the art, is this composite of who you are, how you are, experiences you've had where you might have opportunities, where you might have challenges. It's this kind of story of you, but it's also this point in time photo of you right now, because I also track these differently. People will come back after a period of months or years and get subsequent portraits and we see where their energy shifts and change, because none of us are static, we're all fluid.

That makes total sense. Yeah, and is it an art form for what our spirits are picking up? Everybody's had the experience where we walk into a room and it feels like, ew, this room doesn't feel good, there's something going on here. Or we walk into a room we think, oh, this feels like a party, this feels really fun. Even as small children, we pick up on that. Is that what we're picking up on and your art represents that? Do you think?

I think that's an element of it. I would say it goes a little beyond that. Well, it depends how amplified somebody's broadcast frequency is. That's what my team is saying right now. So we're picking up on elements of that. Certainly, and I forgot to mention, a fun part of the story

was when I was still not sure what these were going to be, I started seeing the shape and the color on people's bodies instead of their heads, and that's when I was like, okay, team, we got to do something with this. Like I can't because, like the UPS man would bring me a package and I'm trying to see where I can even see him to thank him, and all I see is like this floating blob of geometry Wow.

It was a little impractical for a minute until I corralled it into something.

The other thing that's interesting too and this just came into my head, Heather, when I first started learning how to do this stuff and the thing that attracted me to it was the healing stuff first, and then what I figured out once you connect with spirit, then you can do it all. But as I was learning the energy healing stuff, I started to see grids on people. It was almost like an architectural blueprint drawing and I would see these lines and I would see these different geometrical lines and shapes and things like that, and then eventually got into I can see body parts now internally in somebody, but I never thought about it before, but that's how it came into me was in lines that again would mimic a blueprint of a building or a home or something. All right, well enough, intro. That was a great intro. Show us my what do you call it? Energy signature. What do you?

Energetic signature portrait. It's beautiful. When Chris gave it to me, I was so touched and I love that you did it.

Okay, and I want to say too, if anyone's interested in ordering these, one of the things that I offer with this as an add-on is this kind of drill down or examination in it, which some people choose to have, some don't, some like to just sit with it themselves, but this is kind of an example of what we would talk about in one of those conversations. So I like to start by zooming all the way in. So if anyone's watching, sorry for being a little bit erratic there with the zooming in, but as it was explained to me by my team, the very center of the portrait, almost like the middle of a pin cushion, is the seed of your soul entirely.

So I like to think of it looks kind of like a cross shape, but a flower cross shape.

Correct. I like at the very center. Weren't we just talking about yellow too?

before we came on the call and I'll say too there are generic explanations or commonalities in some of the colors and shapes, but everything is always unique to the individual. So, for instance, yellow often means a good communicator and a good teacher, which I know that you are. Someone else may have yellow and it may be that they had a certain experience with yellow and that's why it's in their field or in their soul, because it's part of who they are, due to something else. So even though there are, it's my favorite color.

Well and my house right at the heart of you.

A huge part of my house is painted yellow inside. Yeah, yeah, I love that.

It looks also to me like the little splashes of pink in front of the yellow. Those look like little hearts a little bit. So everything is, I would say, everything for you boils down to a heart-centered faith in one form or another. And then out from that there is a bit of a cobalt blue, a darker blue, which for me is often related to communication and not just being a clear communicator, valuing clear communication, prioritizing clear communication. So I think you are someone who appreciates when someone can be aligned in what they're saying too, not just say it clearly, but mean what they say, say what they mean, maybe even being I don't think you're afraid of the direct communication, either giving it or receiving it. But it's done again from that space of love. And let me know if anything sounds outlandish or completely off in any of this or if you have questions as we go through any of it you know I'm not shy.

We do Exactly the direct communication Right. True.

Outside from this, we have this really fun, interesting. It almost looks like a pyramid shape in here and it's interesting to me because I see to me I see that as three and you just earlier in our conversation we talked about the number three and the divine meaning of that. So as we're going out from that center of you, this turns into more of your expression and your way of being in the world. So I think you are, of course and everyone watching already knows this connected to the divine in a way that because of these are like triangles, which are kind of structure. I think you help people overcome obstacles with their own connection and you fortify and give a foundation to that. I like the part where the little bottom section of the lower triangle is open. That feels to me like you are channeling and bringing things through in a way that is supportive for others.

And they look like Cs. These pyramids have these. For those of you that are listening, they have these spine lines. So there's one on the top, there's one in the middle and then the base that Heather is referring to is very boldened. I guess I'll say, and it's open, that's what you're talking about. But they all look like C's in different configurations. Is that because Chris gave it to me? So it's a C for Chris? I don't think so I'm making a joke.

But I got Christ consciousness. Oh, I love that when I saw the C, and it's not just from Christ, it's from you know, spirit from source, and some people call it Christ consciousness. But that's what I got. For the sea, did you get anything for that?

for the sea, not specifically no, and I will point out, too, that that's what I love about these pieces is.

I am just an observer of them. I'm the facility that they come through and I'm the observer and I'm, you know, tuning into what I can. But often the recipient or the subject of the portrait has their own thing with it. Sometimes people will see faces of loved ones in, like the colors and the backgrounds, and that's nothing I would see. In fact, I have one particular client. Almost every time we talk about one of her pieces of art, she's like I know, you see that there's a wolf there, and I'm like I really don't. If.

I tried to draw a wolf, I couldn't do it. So it's interesting we see what we're supposed to see, which is also tying back to trusting your intuition and trusting your feeling. I've also had many people tell me that their portraits will change over time, so they will notice something one day and swear it wasn't there the next day, or vice versa.

I'm seeing a lot of the triangles, the pyramid thing in a bunch of this. There are triangular shapes all over it in different configurations, and what's coming to mind to me for that is the pyramids as energy generators. I love that.

That. I certainly am an energy generator when I'm working with people who call into the show or clients.

Yes, Interesting, I would say too. Even in your kind of world pre this you were someone who got things moving and going and an idea generator and a builder right, so those feel like building blocks to me as well. In that I also want to talk about the splashes of color kind of here that it looks like somebody took paint and just flung it behind some of these shapes. That is often someone who is coloring outside the lines. We might say a little bit, doing things that are different. Someone says Zig, you may zag, adding a different bit of flair to things that you do in life.

I'm going to zoom out a little bit. I'm an entrepreneur, so of course yeah.

Exactly yeah, blazing your own trail.

Perfect. I wanted to mention too, as I'm zooming out, in case it happens here sometimes spirit takes over and moves the portraits independent of me. That's happened on more than one occasion, so just a fair warning for that. They may behave today, though, so we'll see. The next thing that I'm called to talk about is this there's like a pale purple lavender, with these little sparks of light in there, and that feels to me. I don't know, and you don't have to reveal for us here, of course, but this feels like a new offering, a new idea, something brewing that hasn't

really come to fruition in its full form yet, and if that's not something that's already on deck for you, it may be coming soon.

You're right on target, because I'm starting to develop an intro to energy healing course. Nice, that's a beginner course. That's going to be for everybody. Certainly, my advanced angelic attendant training is all of it. But yeah, that we're. We're right in the middle of that right now and it will be available in a couple of months.

And I love like, if I zoom in just on that part there's that kind of thick line of that. So since it's purple, that always also ties in for me for intuition and healing. So I think that's interesting there.

The curves, for me, are often opportunities or areas where we should surrender and not be so structured about something. So for somebody, that might be I need to be a little more creative in something. Or for somebody else it might be oh, I'm in conflict with my spouse right now. I should back off that a little bit and turn the heat down slightly. Whatever it means. For somebody, it may be a little bit different, since it's coming in presentation close to where this is, with that kind of new offering energy.

I think it's that it's surrender into anything. Wherever there's an obstacle, they're saying like step away from it, back away, instead of plowing through and pushing through back away instead, and then coming out of there. There's again beautiful gold, slash yellow. We're going to wear yellow in all the forms today. This feels like an expression of more mastery. So someone who is explaining things in a way from a very experiential foundation, in a way that allows others to be elevated and it ties into this particular part here elevated in a way that connects those other people you are communicating with to love because of this beautiful kind

of mauvey pink color in here which I would say there looks like a figurine in here. For me too that looks angelic. I don't know if you kind of see it.

It looks to me like a Hawaiian, or like a totem almost.

And then we've got actual heart shapes in here, which is not surprising.

Again tuning into everything that you are putting out in the world broadcasting. Sharing, not even from a true definition of broadcasting, but the metaphorical you're sharing something with the world is through a perspective and a filter of love, so profoundly that we had to stick the hearts in here to make sure you really got it in that interpretation. And then this next kind of section I want to talk about. It looks like hot pink or red with some mottled gold into a gold section that then has some I was going to say furry We'll go with that Some furry kind of pale white color. There's purple, blue and green.

I sound like I'm I don't know labeling a crayon box or something, but in general, this particular area is for you, Julie, 2025 coming up Powerful, a powerful, potent year for turning opportunities into progress, turning any kind of open door into something larger. They show me like stepping up on a platform in a different way. So I think it just they're saying it's success, it's fun, it is an up-leveling in that way, but also because of that blue and the way it almost looks like mini waves inside that bright blue color, be sure to cool things down that get too hot. It's about the balance of this and that is what's going to help alchemize and transform things for you in this coming year. And then, if we go to what I call because I have no other way, after five plus years of doing this, to describe this other than the bubble layer, because it have no other way, after five plus years of doing this to describe this other than the bubble layer, because it looks like bubbles to me that feels like it can mean a couple of things for people. Often it is a presence of your higher self and your guides and your energy. Here looks extremely beautiful and coherent and kind of broadcasting yellow again in some of the presentation, kind of the four corners or the top, bottom and the two sides here Absolutely beautiful support that you have from your team, which, again, anyone watching it's not surprising that that would appear here. And then the background colors are incredibly vibrant, which to me also represents you. You're a very vibrant person. They're very strong. They are also kind of thematically connected to teaching and support and broadcasting and healing. This pop of almost like a red down here red doesn't show up very often in my portraits, so when I do find it, it always kind of catches my attention and here it feels like this call to and expression of you being very grounded in all that you do.

There is a very practical application to what you're doing and I think you also have a mind to keep yourself grounded in it, even in the woo, and I think that's a beautiful way that you weave that together in what it is that you do. That anyone can learn it. It's practical, it's a skill you can

develop and practice, and there's a very beautiful aspect to pulling that down into someone's awareness because it empowers them, but it also almost not demystifying in a bad way, but it takes the shine off of the oh, I couldn't do that, it's too spiritual or I couldn't do that, it's too whatever You're like, no, you really could actually. Let's work on it. So bringing that in for somebody in a very beautiful way.

I also see this kind of bluish, purple, bright line at the top. Those are often guides as well. I like to think of it as if you were looking at like a Polaroid or an actual picture of someone somebody going behind like somebody's head and making a little. So that's kind of a flyby or a stop from one of your guides, and blue for me often ties in with galactic energy. So there you go for that, look out, watch your driveway, watch for snow and the bubble that's around it.

When you were talking about that, Heather, what I got out of that is it's the equivalent of the energy field membrane.

There are pyramids in the energy-filled membrane. A lot of it kind of almost looks like petals, like you know, a semicircle kind of thing. But then at the top, the bottom and both sides there's that pyramid structure again which we're seeing a lot of. What are the cloud-looking segments down at the bottom, primarily really pronounced on the left side, some on the right side and then there's some in the upper right corner.

Just the way they're going to say. That is, this is more the energy that is kind of in your aura around you. So that can be you broadcasting it out, that can be you receiving it. It's often a little bit of both. I like to use the example of walking into a store where there's spring perfume. You know, you kind of get some of it on you in that way. So this is kind of just the way you are vibing in the world right now, and the fact that you know the clouds just take different shape because they're kind of moving and morphing in. As I look at this, it's always even though it's a stagnant piece of art in its presentation, when I observe it it's always moving and breathing, and so that is your energy field as well, pulsating and moving and vibrating in different ways.

The thing about all those colors that surround the main part of the portrait are interesting because they seem to be more vibrant and more concentrated than the ones even inside the graphics and the symbols. And all of that Is that common that you see that that's the case, or is that just me?

It's not uncommon, but it's not every single portrait that happens. What that often represents for me is someone who is in balance with the way they present themselves in the world and the way they are internally or just in balance in general.

Okay, because the orange in those areas around the geometrical shapes are more vivid than they are inside the shapes.

1:01:18 - Heather

And I'll tell you something too it doesn't apply every time and my team never tells me if it really applies for any particular portrait, and you don't have to reveal it if you don't want to. But when I initially started doing these, I asked for some kind of logic, like give me something that makes sense in this weird thing that I'm doing, and initially they mapped out sections of the portrait to represent different periods of time for someone, so they're always a snapshot of where you are now.

But, if you were to look at where you are now, as the very center of the portrait and I'm talking specifically about, like, the cloud layer in the background, the left, the left-hand side was more things that occurred in your life for the past two or three months. So, as we look at yours, those oranges are really popping on that side and that, to me, is birthing something, creativity, bringing an idea to full generation. And then the right, the middle again, would be like the present time. So that might be we were doing this around the holidays, so time with family and really connecting in with some of those pinks of compassion and love and things like that. And then the right hand side would be what's coming up for you in the next two to three months. So, again, staying really grounded as you're putting something through, having clear communication with it. With the blues on the top there's some purple tying into intuition there as well.

Fascinating, it's beautiful. For those of you that are listening, we'll put a shot of it on my social media so that'll be easy for you to see it and then, if you have the opportunity to watch this on YouTube on the Ask Julie Ryan channel, then you'll be able to see it as Heather zooming in and out of the portrait. And I just wanted everybody to see this and hear you explain it, heather, because I think it's fascinating and, from what you sent me about the information that your guides were channeling as you were putting all of that together, it was right on, I mean it was there wasn't anything that I thought, man, that doesn't apply to me.

I mean, it was very accurate of what you were talking about there. So how long? Does it take you to do that and what's your process when you do that?

So it depends. Some people's energy comes in and I think that's kind of like, you know, when you meet somebody it's like, oh, she's all there, like some people's energy just comes right in like a comet and it'll take me maybe 45 minutes to an hour. Other people it can take up to two hours to do. Sometimes I will start someone, get about two hours in and then the team says come back to it another time, so I'll kind of revisit their portrait. But typically I'm doing it in one session for somebody, so anywhere from one to two hours for that, and my process is I don't meet with anybody first. I like to have as few details as possible and I just have their name and their geographic location and that, for some reason, is the key that unlocks whatever.

This is for me. And in a digital art application it's all hand-drawn. None of it is computer generated. But I will go in and just kind of go into a channeled state and be kind of a light. I like to think of it like a light conscious sedation at the dentist. You know, getting work done. I'm still there, but if I am purposefully saying, oh, I know Julie, I bet she'll have a lot of purple because she works with intuition. Inevitably something happens with the app where I, as Heather, cannot control something. They will erase brushstrokes, they will turn my iPad off, something happens. So I have to get out of there and just let whatever comes through come through, and then I do the interpretation or the reading of it and the channeled messages after when I go back as a viewer. So I kind of am wearing two different hats with it during the process.

So all of those geographic designs that are in there, you're doing all that freehand Mm-hmm. Good, how You're reminding me of those little, you know, clear plastic things that were tongue and groove. Yeah, the spirograph. The pirate spirograph yeah.

Maybe I practiced enough as a kid that it's just in there. It's like muscle memory.

It's so precise, do you put it through some kind of a program to tighten it up once you've drawn?

Mm-mm, mm-mm. Wow, because I thought it was computer generated. I thought you were doing.

I know that's why I always have to give that disclaimer that no, it isn't. Yeah. So I mean, it's not just me, my team is completely. Do you start in the middle and then?

you work out? Do you start out and work in? I start in the middle and work out.

Okay, and then the colors are filled in. So do you draw? The Cloud layer happens first, and I say that it happens in its first iteration. Sometimes I'll come back to it after the geometry, but the cloud layer happens first. I do the outline of the geometry next. Then I will do primary. I don't mean primary like red, green, blue, but the first layer of colors in just a normal kind of wash of paint. And then there's a texture layer where you saw some of those things where they were like it looked like waves or it's modeled or there's glitter. That is its own kind of application.

That comes after, and if I come out of channeling and look at that, it's not kind of in the middle. I'm like, ah, this one's not going to be really pretty because they don't look great until they're done. And I always get worried halfway through like, oh man, this one's no good. But then beyond me everything comes together and coalesces. And then the bubble layer. Different people have different things behind their main geometry. Sometimes it's a grid, sometimes it's lines, sometimes it's light shooting out, it just depends. And then some final touches of maybe there's some extra light that wants to come in the cloud layer, Maybe something another texture wants to come in. Maybe I need a different shadow somewhere Gets a little finicky at the end and then I just get this sense of you're done and then that's it. That's a wrap.

Are you cognizant of what's going on the whole time you're doing it? Or is it spirit just moving your hand?

I'm cognizant, so I'm in there. I'm in here. I'm just not the driver or the doer of it. I'm just kind of almost like automatic writing, but it's automatic whatever, automatic arting, automatic drawing.

Right. So when you do this for people, how do they use it to enhance their lives? I mean, the stuff that you told me is all stuff that I basically know, so how do I take that and integrate it into a way that it's going to enhance my life?

Well, for a lot of people and I just heard this the other day and I think it's one of the best testimonials I can give to answer that question I spoke with a client all the way around the world, in Israel, and she said it's such a comfort for me to know that you, all the way on the other side of the world, who never met me, doesn't know me, but got these messages about me and understands that this is who I am as a soul. So for a lot of people it's a confirmation of what they already know but maybe aren't hearing back from loved ones or are afraid to share with others or maybe won't even admit for themselves. In that way and I'll go back to when I was initially practicing with my group of friends it's the visceral reaction that I think you, because of the work that you do and the beautiful soul that you are, you're used to that ooeygooey feeling kind of thing. A lot of people will witness their portrait and feel something that they haven't felt before. I often hear people say like that's the first time I've seen myself. I look in the mirror and that's not me, but I look at this portrait and that's who I am. They'll put them on their lock screens on their phones or their devices to remind themselves of who they are in this world that sometimes tries to make us be something we're not.

And then I think, the more that somebody gets attuned to working with the observation of the portrait and working with energy in general, they're able to then say, oh, especially clients who will have I do these as a package where you get four in a year as well, if somebody wants something, not just a single one, and when we do four in a year they'll look back and say, oh, there's my divorce, I see where that was in my energy. Or there's the job opportunity I turned down. They're able to kind of fine tune and reaffirm for themselves or see in advance like, like, oh, this one, it looks like my energy is a little more open. What have I been doing lately? Well, I've been sleeping better, I've been working out, I've been eating healthy, I got rid of the friends that were pulling me down or whatever it is, and they can kind of calibrate how they move through life based on what they're seeing reflected back in the art. It's really very cool and there's no right way to work with it. So it varies from person to person.

I have one last question for you and before we get there, I would love if you would check in with your peeps, your guides, and see if they have a message for us today here, as there's so much going on. Certainly you're in North Carolina and the hurricane has affected people in your area and they are still recovering from so many people lost their homes and all of that. And then we magnify it to right now these horrific fires are happening in Los Angeles and last count I heard was over 12,000 homes have been lost and the fires are only, they're burning in about four or five different areas, and I lived in LA for a long time and I called on all the hospitals out there, so I know LA County probably better than most people have lived there all their lives.

Could you tell me a city and I can tell you what hospitals are there, even from 40 years ago when I was a sales rep? But they're in all these different areas and everything's so taxed and it's just so. Many of these people don't have insurance and it's such a tough time on these people, not only where you are in North Carolina and elsewhere where there's strife and conflict in the world, but especially in our zeitgeist race right now with what's going on in Los Angeles. Do your guys have anything that they want to tell us about that or any encouragement or suggestions that they want to volunteer?

Yeah, so I can kind of I won't trans channel them, but there's some messages that they were pushing through when you were saying that specifically, and there's a couple of ways to not interpret but to witness or perceive what's going on. So just doing that internal calibration for yourself a little bit, so that we are all rising up, and the team is saying also picturing the phoenix rising out of the ashes of adversity, so that we're all rising up out of these traged anything, but it's like a coexistent factor.

Our world was running really hot coming out of 2024.
